

8. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanations):

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:

Hon. Ibrahim Tawa Conteh of Constituency 132, Western Urban District informed the House about a gruesome accident that took place at the Lumbley Police Junction on Saturday 17th December 2022 which had led to the death of fifteen children and many others in critical condition. He said that the multiplicity of schools outreach activities had led to that effect. He also reminded the House about the drowning of two children in 2021 from the similar school outreach activities. He therefore called upon the House to call upon the attention of the Minister of Basic and Senior Secondary Education and the Minister of Transport and Aviation.

Mr. Speaker informed the House that on Sunday 18th December 2022 he was in the Eastern Part of Freetown, and that to his surprise, he saw three different thanksgiving matches by very young school children using the midpoint of the highway, and that vehicles were plying on both sides of the children. He stated that the said issues seemed to be a phenomenon. Mr. Speaker asked the House to help the Government by passing a resolution that could solve the said issue once and for all if the authorities concerned could not.

The Whip of Opposition, **Hon. Hassan A. Sesay,** informed the House that the bus that led to the said accident had parked for a very long time, and that it was only brought out on that day with few repairs for the said outing. He stated that the said area had been notorious for accident. He asked the House to be proactive in addressing the said issue.

Mr. Speaker also informed the House about a time when a vehicle that was running down Spur Road had an accident and went straight to the living room of Reverend Davies. He said that had it been that Rev. Davies and his family were in the living room, it would have been a different story.

The Leader of Opposition, **Hon. Cherrnor R.M. Bah** submitted that the Minister of Basic and Senior Secondary Education should be invited while the Minister of Transport and Aviation should be summoned.

Hon. Emilia Lolloh Tongi submitted that the Road worthiness of some of those vehicles had been the cause of most of those gruesome accidents, and that the authorities concerned should be held responsible.

Mr. Speaker's Ruling:

Based on the consensus of the House, the Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, ordered that the Minister of Transport and Aviation should be summoned whilst the Minister of Basic and Senior Secondary Education should be invited.
