3. Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 11<sup>TH</sup> November, 2022:
The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 11<sup>th</sup>
November, 2022 was moved by *Hon. Alieu Ibrahim Kamara of* Constituency 122, Western

5. Bill: The Gender Empowerment Act, 2021 by the Minister of Gender and Children's Affairs:

Committee Stage: The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole.

#### **Presentation of Report:**

The Chairman of the Legislative Committee, Hon. Abdul S. Marray Conteh of Constituency 130, Western Urban District, presented the Sixth Report of the Fifth Session of the Fifth Parliament of the Legislative Committee on the bill entitled "The Gender Empowerment Act, 2021."

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that Parts 1 to 5; Clauses 1 to 16 including the schedules stand part of the bill.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Price Oviasuyi, pronounced that Parts 1 to 5; Clauses 1 to 16 had formed part of the bill as amended.

The House resumed from the Committee Stage.

#### **Report Stage:**

The Minister of Gender and Children's Affairs, **Ms. Manty Tarawally,** reported to the House that the bill entitled: **"The Gender Equality and Women's Empowerment Act, 2022"** had gone through Committee of the Whole House with some amendments made.

#### **Third Reading:**

The Minister of Gender and Children's Affairs, **Ms. Manty Tarawally**, moved that the bill be read the Third Time and passed into law.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote.

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that the bill entitled: "The Gender Equality and Women's Empowerment Act, 2022" had been read the Third Time and passed into law.
