

2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2):

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:15 am was moved by Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District. The motion was seconded by Hon. Josephine Makieu of Constituency 014, Kenema District and approved by the House.

3. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Acting Leader of Government Business (Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District) moved a motion to amend the Order by incorporating a new item (ii) that read as "The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 27th October, 2022." The initial item (ii) became item (III). The motion was seconded by Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District and approved by the House.

4. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Leader of Government Business (Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District) moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by expunging item V (ii) - "The Public Health Act, 2022." from the already amended Order Paper. The motion was seconded by the Deputy Leader of Government Business, Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District and approved by the House.

5. Adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 27th October, 2022:

The motion for the Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 27th October 2022 was moved by Hon. Mohamed Billoh Shaw of Constituency 039, Falaba District. The motion was seconded by Hon. Alieu Ibrahim Kamara of Constituency 122, Western Urban District and adopted as amended.

6. Adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 28th October 2022:

The motion for the Adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 28th October, 2022 was moved by Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District. The motion was seconded by Hon. Massay Ngahinteh Aruna of Constituency 085, Bo District and adopted by the House.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu, drew the attention of the Leader of Government Business to page 7 of the Votes and Proceedings for Friday 28th October, 2022 relating to the motion that was moved by Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella for the House to summon the Minister of Finance, the Bank Governor including all relevant authorities concerned to answer to questions concerning the economic status of the state.

The Leader of Opposition, **Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District,** informed the House about the report that was supposed to be done by the Committees on Transport and Aviation; Internal Affairs and Finance regarding the security tax of \$25 at the Lungi International Airport.

The Chairman of Internal Affairs, **Hon. Alusine Kanneh**, informed the House that he and the Chairman of Transport had done a written letter through the clerks of their committees to summon the relevant authority to the House concerning the said issue.

Mr. Speaker ruled that the report concerning the security tax of \$25 should be submitted on Wednesday 16th November, 2022 as the deadline.

7. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, reminded the House about his announcement during the last sitting relating to the distributions of tablets to all Hon. Members. He informed the House that out of 146 Members of Parliament as of the current composition, just 107 Members of Parliament had filled the questionnaire placed online by the Department of Information, Communications and Technology (ICT). He encouraged Hon. Members that had not done so to do the needful.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Francis Ernest Farma, called upon the Minister of Gender and Children's Affairs to proceed with the Second Reading of the bill.
