



2. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2):

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5 (2) at 11:45 a.m. was moved by Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District. The motion was seconded by Hon. Tennyson Hindolo Sandy of Constituency 120, Western Urban District and approved by the House.

3. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 5th July, 2022:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 5th July, 2022 was moved by **Hon. Mohamed Billoh Shaw of Constituency 039, Falaba District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Ibrahim Alieu Kamara of Constituency 122, Western Urban District** and adopted by the House.

4. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Leader of Government Business, Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019 moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by moving item V (B) (The Public Elections Act, 2022) to a now become item V (A) on the Order Paper. The motion was seconded by Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District and approved by the House.

4. Announcement By Mr. Speaker:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that he intended to adjourn the House latest 1:30 p.m. because he had another Parliamentary function to perform.

5. Swearing-in of Elected Members of Parliament (Third Schedule of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone)

Pursuance to Section 83 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No.6 of 1991), The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Chernor Abass Bundu**, called upon the Clerk of Parliament (**Hon. Paran Umar Tarawally**) to administer the oath of Allegiance as set out in the Third Schedule of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991).

Administering of Oath by the Clerk of Parliament:

The Clerk of Parliament, Hon. Paran Umar Tarawally, invited the Leadership of Parliament to witness the process of administering the oath of Allegiance to the Hon. Member Designate as set out in **The Third Schedule of The Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991).**

Mr. Speaker's Felicitation:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Chernor Abass Bundu**, also welcomed the newly sworn in Member of Parliament. He re-echoed the felicitations directed to NEC by both Leaders and encouraged all Hon. Enquiry by Mr. Speaker:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Chernor Abass Bundu**, asked the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Energy the reason behind the power outage during the last sitting.

The Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee (Hon. Cristopha Keikura Vandy of Constituency 088, Bo
 District) stated that the electrical grid was up and running at the time of the power outage, and that the
 power outage that Parliament was faced with during the last sitting was due to an internal electrical
 problem.

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Chernor Abass Bundu**, concluded that he would ask the Clerk of Parliament to investigate the matter and report to the House accordingly.





6. Bill: The Public Elections Act, 2022 by the Attorney-General and Minister of Justice.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Ismaila Kabba, called upon the Attorney-General and Minister of Justice to proceed with the Second Reading of the bill.

Standing Order 37 (Dilatory Motions):

The Leader of Government Business, Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019 rose on S. O. 37 moved a motion to postpone the debate on the Second Reading of the Bill (The Public Elections Act, 2022) to the next adjourned date. The motion was seconded by the Deputy Leader of Government Business (Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District) and approved by the House.

8. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanation):

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:

- (i) Hon. Mustapha Musa Sellu of Constituency 095, Moyamba District informed the House about an audio that was making rounds on social media with death threats if Hon. Members of the ruling party agreed to pass the Bill entitled (The Public Elections Act, 2022) into law.
- (ii) **Hon. Joseph Bash Kamara of Constituency 084, Bo District** made mention of the disturbances in the chamber during sittings of recent time. He called upon Mr. Speaker to firmly address the issue and put the House back in order as he had always done.





- (iii) **Hon. Ibrahim Kamara of Constituency 063, Karene District** again informed the House about another military brutality in his constituency. He pleaded with Mr. Speaker to speedily intervene in the said issue in his constituency as there had been rumours of another attack.
- (iv) **Hon. Alusine Kainde Alu-Conteh of Constituency 125, Western Urban District** reported to the House about an attack he encountered after the Parliamentary sitting on the 5th July, 2022. He said that an unknown individual pelted him with a stone on the right side of his neck that left him unconscious until he was taken to the **Choithram Memorial Hospital** where he was resuscitated. He pleaded through Mr. Speaker that the security of Hon. Members should be treated with seriousness.
- (v) The Leader of Opposition, Hon. Chernor R. M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District supported the Hon. Member and added that the attack on him was done while he was rendering service to the nation.
