2. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2):

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5 (2) at 10:45 a.m. was moved by Hon. Nenneh Lebbie of constituency 086, Bo District. The motion was seconded by Hon. Mohamed Kanneh of Constituency **006, Kailahun District** and approved by the House.

Observation by Hon. Daniel B. Koroma:

Hon. Daniel B. Koroma of Constituency 046, Koinadugu District extended his gratitude to the Business Committee for its timely production and publication of the Order Paper for the past two years. He implored the Members of the said Committee to continue on that positive performance because he had recently observed that there had been delay in the production of the Order Paper. He also reminded the House about the bill entitled: The National Electronic Communications Act, 2022 that ought to have been on the Order Paper for continuation as expected.

Response by Hon. Bashiru Silikie:

The Acting Leader of Government Business (Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District) apologized to the House for the recent delay in the timely production of Order Paper due to the lateness in chamber. He assured the House that the Business Committee would continue to produce and publish the Order Paper in a timely fashion.

3. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Acting Leader of Government Business (Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District) moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by incorporating a new item IV that would deal with the continuation of the bill entitled: The National Electronic Communications Act, 2022, and that the bill entitled: The Tobacco and Nicotine Control Act, 2021 automatically became item "V." The motion was seconded by Hon. Brima Mansaray of Constituency 017, Kenema District and approved by the House.

Statement by Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella:

The Leader of the National Grand Coalition (NGC) in Parliament and the Chairman of the Special Select Committee set up to look into the issues of fake degrees informed the House that within the past five weeks, the Committee had taken some steps to begin to implement the terms of reference provided to the Committee by Mr. Speaker. He stated that each political party in Parliament nominated Members to the said Special Select Committee and Mr. Speaker himself had encouraged a number of them to serve in that Committee. He emphasized that the key role of the Committee was to coordinate the action of the Standing Committees. He reminded Hon. Members that the work of the said Committee was very delicate and sensitive. He informed the House that the Committee had issued a letter to the Clerk of





Parliament, the Director-General and the Director of the Human Resources of Parliament requesting that all staff of Parliament should make available their certificates for probing and that the deadline was on 15th June 2022. He encouraged all Hon. Members to honour the process by submitting their certificates for probing before the deadline on the 20th June 2022. He stated that certificate has not been a constitutional requirement for an elected Member of Parliament as long as the Hon. Member can speak and write English fluently. He further informed the House about a university at **Daru Road** in Bo that had been offering fake honorary PhDs. He emphatically stated that the Committee needed a secretariat and pleaded for it to be urgently provided. He also informed the House that two out of the three clerks nominated to partake in the exercise had refused to participate in the exercise. He encouraged and advised all those that had been sighted of knowingly or unknowingly possessing fake degree to do the honourable thing by denouncing it. He assured Hon. Members that the Special Select Committee would do its best to achieve its desired results.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu** thanked **Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella** for his submission. He said that it would be important to put politics aside and try to resolve the said issue holistically for the development of the nation. He reminded the House that the takers of the WASSCE Exams had carried on the practice of spying which was one of the spillovers of the said issue as they believed that they could only pass exams by spying. He stated that the government of President Bio had prioritized education as the gateway to the nation's development as well as individual's advancement. He implored all Hon. Members to do the needful and treat the exercise very seriously.

The Whip of the Opposition (Hon. Hassan A. Sesay of Constituency 050, Tonkolili District) thanked Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella for his excellent presentation. He said that the two clerks that had refused to partake in the said exercise should be suspended forthwith. He said that the exercise should be a task that should be undertaken by all of them. He stated that it had been a common practice for teachers to allow students to enter exam halls with their mobile phones for pittance.

The Acting Leader of Government Business (Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District) stated that some of them had said it on several occasions that there would be no way that the Fifth Parliament would politicize education. He thanked His Excellency for investing so much on education. He encouraged the line Committees to do the needful and help the Special Select Committee to achieve its desired results. As for Hon. Members, he referred the House to Section 75 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991). He reminded the House that there was barely nine-month to the end of the Fifth Session and further encouraged all Hon. Members to fully partake in the exercise for the betterment of the nation.





Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that he would engage the Clerk of Parliament to deal with the issue concerning the two clerks that had refused to partake in the exercise.

4. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 15th June, 2022:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 15th June, 2022 was moved by **Hon. Maada Afiju Kanja of Constituency 018, Kenema District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District** and adopted by the House.

5. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, implored all Hon. Members to work assiduously to complete the bill entitled: **The National Electronic and Communications Act, 2022.**

6. Bills:

A. The National Electronic and Communications Act, 2022 by the Minister of Information and Communications:

Committee Stage:

The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole.

The debate continued on the amendments of the said bill starting from Clause 160 of page 120.

7. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2):

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5 (2) at 12:00 p.m. was moved by Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District. The motion was seconded by Hon. Habib Keifa Fabbah of Constituency 078, Bo District and approved by the House.

The Debate Continued:

Mr. Speaker stood down the House at 12:30 p.m.

The House resumed at 12:35 p.m.

The debate continued on the amendments of the said bill.

The amendment of the said bill was stopped at part 36 of Clause 180.

The House resumed from the Committee Stage.





Mr. Speaker adjourned the House for lunch at 1:35 p.m. The House resumed at 3:15 p.m.

8. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2):

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5 (2) at 3:15 p.m. was moved by Hon. Moses B. Jorkie of Constituency 091, Bonthe District. The motion was seconded by Hon. James Ozan Tholley of Constituency 054, Tonkolili District and approved by the House.

Continued proceedings.

Bill: The Tobacco and Nicotine Control Act, 2021 by the Minister of Health and Sanitation:

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Ismaila Kabba**, called upon The Minister of Health and Sanitation to proceed on the **Committee Stage**, of the bill.

Committee Stage - The Mace was covered. The Wigs of Mr. Chairman and Table Clerks were taken off:

The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole.

Presentation of Report:

The Chairman of the Legislative Committee, **Hon. Abdul S. Marray Conteh of Constituency 130, Western Urban District,** presented the First Report of the Fifth Session of the Fifth Parliament of the Legislative Committee on the bill entitled **"The Tobacco and Nicotine Control Act, 2021."**

The House resumed from the Committee Stage.
