#### 2. Suspension of S.O. 5 (2):

The suspension of S.O. 5 (2) at 11:00 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Neneh Lebbie of Constituency 086, Bo District** and approved by the House.

### 3. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2021:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 was moved by **Hon. Brima Mansaray of Constituency 017, Kenema District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District** and adopted by the House with an amendment.

#### 4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, again emphasized on the issue of punctuality and admonished all Hon. Members to make an improvement on it.

He also updated Hon. Members about the reports that would be dealt with on that day's sitting and advised that all Chairmen together with their Clerks should ensure that their reports were completed and distributed by the end of the business day.

Hon. Dr. Mark Mamoud Kalokoh of Constituency 032, Bombali District rose on Sections 5(2b), 17(1), 18(1) and 25(1) of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991). He said that it was the responsibility of the Government to protect lives and properties of its citizens as well as to protect its citizens from arbitrary arrest or detention. He cited the recent invitation, detention and arrest of Political Opposition Members like the Chairman of the Consortium of Progressive Political Parties (COPPP), the Chairman and Leader of the National Grand Coalition (NGC.) etc. He implored Mr. Speaker to use his good office as the Head of the Legislative Arm of Government and Third in Command to intervene on the issue raised. He reminded the House that Mr. Speaker was one of the active participants that drafted the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone and that the provisions of the said constitution should be respected.

Bill: The Appropriation Act, 2022 by the Minister of Finance (Third Allotted Day)
