- 1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Senior Table Clerk).
- 2. Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 23rd July, 2021:

The motion for the adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 23rd July, **2021** was moved by **Hon. Nenneh Lebbie of Constituency 086, Bo District.** It was seconded by **Hon. Tennyson Hindolo Sandy of Constituency 120, Western Urban District** and adopted by the House.

3. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker (**Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**) welcomed all Hon. Members from the recess. He said he sincerely hoped that they were all well rested and well prepared to undertake and execute the tasks ahead. E. The Gender Empowerment Act, 2021 by the Minister of Gender and Children's Affairs.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis E. Farma**, called upon the Minister of Gender and Children's Affairs to proceed with the **Introduction and First Reading** of the bill.

Introduction and First Reading:

The Minister of Gender and Children's Affairs, **Madam Manti Tarawalli**, moved that the bill entitled "**The Gender Empowerment Act, 2021**" be read the **First Time**.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye"

"All those against, say Nay"

Through the collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Francis E. Farma, pronounced that the bill had been read the First Time.

10. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanations):

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:

(i) The Acting Leader of Opposition (Hon. Ibrahim Ben Kargbo of Constituency 034, Bombali District) referred the House to Section 39, sub-section 1 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991) and recited the aforementioned provision as quoted: "When the seat of any Member of Parliament becomes vacant, the vacancy shall be filled by election, not later than six months after the vacancy occurs, in accordance with the provisions of law relating to such election; Provided that if Parliament is dissolved before such election is due to be held, the vacancy shall be filled at the general election." He reminded the House about a bye election that was held in the Tonkolili District upon which an Hon. Member of Parliament was elected as a paramount chief. He informed the House that their worry was that the gentleman has been continuously holding the position of paramount chief as well as Hon. Member of Parliament. He said for the purposes of consistency and democratic practices, they would want to be certain that the said gentleman be replaced.





(ii) Hon. Alpha Amadu Bah of Constityuency 115, Western Urban District (in support to the concerns raised by the Acting Leader of Opposition) referred the House to Section 77, sub-section (1 f) of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991) and recited the aforementioned provision as quoted: "A Member of Parliament shall vacate his seat in Parliament – (f) if in the case of such a Member as is referred to in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 74, he becomes a Paramount Chief under any law..." He submitted that the said seat had been vacant from the day the gentleman was pronounced Paramount Chief of that chiefdom.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, thanked **Hon. Alpha Amadu Bah** for his submission but said that his submission was a matter of opinion of which would not guide him in the said matter. He said that the only thing that would guide him in the said matter would be an official notification from the Chairman of the National Electoral Commission (NEC). He finally said that he would not take note of the issue until he received an official notification.

(iii) The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Segepoh Solomon Thomas of Constituency 089, Bonthe District) informed the House about the death of the mother of the Chief Whip of Parliament (Hon. Dickson M. Rogers) whose demise took place on the 10th of August 2021 when the House was in recess. He notified the House that she had already been buried. He kindly craved the indulgence of Mr. Speaker for a minute of silence to be observed for the mother of the Chief Whip as well as the mother of Hon. Peter Musa Moigua of Constituency 011, Kenema District as requested by the Deputy Leader of Government Business.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, asked all to rise and observe a minute of silence. He recited the following prayer as quoted: "May the gentle souls of the faithful departed rest in perfect peace."
