1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Table Clerk).

2. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District** moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by interchanging the two sub-items under the main item "IV" – **(Laying of Papers).** He also moved to replace the Minister of Fisheries and Marine Resources with the Minister of Lands, Housing and Country Planning under sub-item "C" of the main item "VI" – (Government Motions). The motion was seconded by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District** and approved by the House.

3. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 26th November, 2021:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Friday 26th November, 2021 was moved by Hon. Moses Baimba Jorkie of Constituency 091, Bonthe District. It was seconded by Hon. Dr. Mark Mahmoud Kalokoh of Constituency 034, Bombali Distict and adopted by the House.

4. Mr. Speaker's Announcements:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu, made the following announcements:

He informed the House about the increased cases of the new variant of the Covid-19 (Omicron). He said that it behooved every Hon. Member in the House to honour the relevant protocols.

He also informed the House about the notification from the Office of the Clerk concerning Hon. Members that had been using unregistered vehicles. He advised all Hon. Members that had been in the habit of plying with unregistered vehicles to do the needful as required by law.

He further informed the House about the death of **Dr. Alusine Fofanah** who was once a Hon. Member of Parliament. He asked all to rise and observe a minute's silence. He recited the following prayer as quoted: "May the almighty Allah forgive his transgressions and grant him eternal rest in His heavenly kingdom."

The Leader of Opposition, Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District, informed the House about the death of the mother of Hon. Ibrahim Aziz Bangura of Constituency 076, Port Loko District.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

In response to the announced bereavement made by the Leader of Opposition, the Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, again asked all to rise and observe a minute's silence for the death of **Hon. Ibrahim Aziz Bangura's mother**. He recited the following prayer as quoted: "May the soul of the faithful departed rest in perfect peace."





Hon. Dr. Mark Mahmoud Kalokoh of Constituency 034, Bombali District rose on Sections 5 (2b) and (17) of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991). He recited the provision of section 5 sub-section (2 b) as quoted: "the security, peace and welfare of the people of Sierra Leone shall be the primary purpose and responsibility of Government, and to this end it shall be the duty of the Armed Forces, the Police, Public Officers and all security agents to protect and safeguard the people of Sierra Leone." He informed the House about the activities of the Police and said that their activities had become unbearable. He made mention of places like Up-gun, Cline Town, Ferry Junction, Shell New Road, Texaco etc. where many police officers had been deployed doing unbearable activities (like chasing commercial bike riders, drivers etc.) He said that "it is the duty of the police to protect the lives of Sierra Leoneans but they are abusing and killing them."

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, advised him to make use of S.O. 23 (Personal Explanations as well as Questions that should be directed to the relevant MDA in question. He encouraged him to revert to the issues raised when they had finished with the items on the Order Paper.

5. Laying of Papers:



10. Bill: The Allied Health Professions Act, 2020.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Ismaila Kabba**, called upon the Chairman of the Legislative Committee to do a presentation on the bill.

Presentation of the Legislative Committee's Report:

The Chairman of the Legislative Committee, **Hon. Abdul S. Marray Conteh of Constituency 130, Western Urban District,** presented the Third Report of the Fourth Session of the Fifth Parliament of the Legislative Committee on the bill entitled: **"The Allied Health Professions Act, 2020."**

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, thanked the Chairman of the Legislative Committee for the presentation of his report. He said that the House would consider the Report of the Legislative Committee together with the bill page by page at the next adjourned date. He ordered the resumption of the House.

The House resumed from the Committee of the Whole House.

The Mace was uncovered. The Wigs of Mr. Chairman and the Table Clerks were put on.

Mr. Speaker's Admonishment to Hon. Dr. Mark M. Kalokoh:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, advised him to present the issues that he had earlier deferred in the form of questions to the relevant Ministers. As an undertaking, he declared that **Hon. Dr. Mark M. Kalokoh's** guestions on the issues raised would be addressed.

11. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanations):

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:





- (i) Hon. Dr. Mark Mahmoud Kalokoh of Constituency 034, Bombali District, referred the House to section 17 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991) and informed the House about the arbitrary arrests of some of their people at Bombali District through the directives of the Inspector General of Police, Ambrose Michael Sovula. He said that the arrested people were brought to Freetown and detained at the CID Headquarters without telling them the offence that they had committed. He asked that those people should be released unconditionally. He finally stated that: "they want to continue to enjoy the peace of the country but the activities of the police are definitely pushing them to the corner."
- (ii) The Leader of Opposition, Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District, informed the House that he had been from the CID Headquarters and that the arrested people from Bombali District had taken statements but their statements had no bearing to their arrests. He said that he had not seen nowhere in the world where the President of a state had taken a decision concluding a matter, and the police went further and opened it. He pleaded with Mr. Speaker to intervene on the said issue to ensure the release of those people.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu, asked for a proper briefing on the said issue.
