- 1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Senior Table Clerk).
- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:40 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S. O. 5 (2) at 10:40 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Habib Kaifa Fabbah of Constituency 078, Bo District** and approved by the House.

3. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 26th April, 2022:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 26th April, 2022 was moved by **Hon. Tennyson Hindolo Sandy of Constituency 120, Western Urban District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Maada Kanja Hafiju of Constituency 018, Kenema District** and adopted by the House.

4. Announcement by Mr. Speaker:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu** again expressed concern over the quality of renovation work that was done in Parliament.

Hon. Segepoh Solomon Thomas of Constituency 098, Bonthe District drew the attention of Mr. Speaker and the House about an invitation that had already been printed and distributed with an agenda in the program "Unveiling of Plaque" that should not be part of the program. He said the substantive Speaker had already ruled on the said matter before the invitation and program was printed and sent out but to see it appear on the invitation was a surprise to him. He warned against Parliament being seen as an accomplice.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, said that there were two issues on floor that needed to be addressed. The first he said had to deal with the invitation for the Open Day that had been issued out under his office without prior notification. Mr. Speaker completely distanced himself from the act and made it clear that it was only now in the chamber courtesy of his Deputy that he had set eyes on the invitation card with the program attached to it.

The second issue was the concern he raised over the quality of the renovation work done in Parliament which Hon. Members including the Leadership and he himself had expressed dissatisfaction. Mr. Speaker said he had ruled on that matter in the previous sitting and awaits the report from the Committee on Works after the State Opening of Parliament.

The Speaker, Rt. Hon. **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu** directed that the Leadership met with him immediately after adjournment in his chamber and that the invitation card be withdrawn forthwith.





5. Government Motion by the Minister of Information and Communications

The Senior Table Clerk, **Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston**, called upon the Minister of Information and Communications.

The Deputy Minister of Information and Communications, **Mr. Solomon Jamiru**, moved a motion with the following words as quoted:
