- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:35 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S. O. 5 (2) at 10:35 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Mohamed Billoh Shaw of Constituency 039, Falaba District** and approved by the House.

3. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 28th April, 2022:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 28th April, 2022 was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Simeon Fefegula of Constituency 096, Moyamba District** and adopted by the House.

4. Announcement by Mr. Speaker:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu** again reminded Hon. Members about the Open Day of Parliament that was scheduled to take place on the 5th to 7th May 2022. He encouraged all Hon. Members to take ownership of the said program by attending and inviting their constituents. He said that in the not too distant future, the Open Day would be conducted in major regions across the country so that every citizen would be able to access Parliament and learn about the work of Parliament.

Mr. Speaker's second announcement was about the Electronic Communication Bill that was before the House. He said that the report from the Legislative Committee captured all the amendments in the bill, and that the bill itself was a very bulky document. He, therefore, encouraged all Hon. Members to speed up the bill judiciously.

Mr. Speaker reminded the House about the Private Member's Motion that was adopted by Parliament on Thursday 21st April, 2022. He announced the membership of the Special Select Committee as he made his statement below.

"Pursuant to the Resolution of Parliament adopted at its 55th Sitting on Thursday, 21st April 2022, that the House constitute a Special Select Committee to conduct a Certificate Audit of all holders of public office in Sierra Leone, particularly those claiming to have acquired academic, professional and technical diplomas and degrees, and following due consultations with the Leadership of Parliament, I hereby announce the said Special Select Committee with the following membership:

8. A competent officer from the Parliamentary Service shall be appointed to serve as the Secretary of the Committee.

The Special Select Committee shall have the following terms of reference:

- To direct all the Standing Committees of Parliament to compel all MDAs within the purview of their oversight responsibilities to submit documentary evidence of certificates of diplomas and degrees claimed to be held by all public officers working in the said MDAs;
- (ii) To examine the authenticity of all such certificates and produce a written report with recommendations for the consideration of Parliament;
- (iii) To co-opt any person with requisite competence and expertise to advice or otherwise render assistance to it at any of its meetings but such person shall not vote on any matter for decision by the Special Select Committee;
- (iv) To submit a written report with recommendations to Parliament before the date of dissolution of the Fifth Parliament.

The motion for the adoption of the Special Select Committee constituted to audit the academic certificates of holders of public offices was moved by Hon. James Ozan Tholley of Constituency 054, Tonkolili District and seconded by Hon. Quintin Salia Konneh of Constituency 007, Kailahun District.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Senior Table Clerk, Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston, pronounced that the motion had been carried.

Standing Order 34 (Raising of Point of Order):

Hon. Dr. Mark Mahmoud Kalokoh of Constituency 032, Bombali District rose on Standing Order 34 and reminded Mr. Speaker that there had been a motion on floor to debate the report of the Committee on Mines and Mineral Resources. He stated that the said motion was to avert any further litigation from mining companies.





Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu** responded that he had noted the concern of the Hon. Member and assured him that the report would be surely debated by the start of the Fifth Session.

10. Bill: The National Electronic Communication Act, 2021.

Committee Stage - The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole House.

The Mace was covered. The Wigs of Mr. Speaker and the Table Clerks were taken off:

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, called upon The Minister of Information and Communications to proceed on the Committee Stage of the bill.

The House resumed from the Committee Stage.

The Mace was uncovered. The wigs of Mr. Speaker and the Table Clerks were put on.

Hon. Abdul S. Marray Conteh of Constituency 130, Western Urban moved the amendment of the short title of the bill to be read: "The National Communications Authority Act, 2022"

(i) The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, pronounced that Parts 1 to 10, Clauses 1 to 50 stand part of the bill.

The Deputy Minister of Information and Communications, **Mr. Solomon Jamiru**, moved that Parts 1 to 10, Clauses 1 to 50 stand part of the bill.

Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate. The debate started, and amendments were made.

11. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 12:00 p.m.

The motion for the suspension of S. O. 5 (2) at 12:00 p.m. was moved by **Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District** for the proceedings to continue during lunch. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** and approved by the House.

Continued debate:





Mr. Speaker adjourned the House at 1:00 p.m. for lunch.

The House resumed at 2:00 p.m.

Continued debate on the amendments of the said bill.

12. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 3:00 p.m.

The motion for the suspension of S. O. 5 (2) at 3:00 p.m. was moved by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District** for the proceedings to continue after the said time. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Abdul Latif Sesay of Constituency 075, Port Loko District** and approved by the House.

Continued debate on the amendments of the said bill.

Standing Order 59 (Withdrawal of Bills)

The Acting Leader of Government Business, Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District moved a motion for the suspension of S.O. 59 (2) so that all the bills before the House would continue unto the final stage and be passed into law after the end of the Fourth Session. The motion was seconded by the Whip of Opposition (Hon. Hassan A. Sesay of Constituency 050, Tonkolili District) and approved by the House.

The House resumed from the Committee Stage.

The mace was uncovered. The wigs of Mr. Chairman and the Table Clerks were put on.
