- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:40 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S. O. 5 (2) at 10:40 a.m. was moved by Hon. Tennyson Hindolo Sandy of Constituency 120, Western Urban District for the Commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by Hon. Abdul Muniru Lansana of Constituency 121, Western Urban District and approved by the House.

3. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 9th February, 2022:
The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Wednesday 9th February, 2022 was moved by Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District. It was seconded by Hon. Ishmail Sama Sandy of Constituency 080, Bo District and adopted by the House.

4. Laying of Papers

The Table Clerk, **Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston**, called upon the Minister of Transport and Aviation to lay the Papers that were itemized on the Order Paper.

5. Bill: The Professional Engineering Regulatory Council, Act, 2021 by the Minister of Works and Public Assets.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, called upon the Minister of Works and Public Assets to proceed with the **Introduction and First Reading of the bill**.

Introduction and First Reading

The Minister of Works and Public Assets, Mr. Peter Bayuku Konteh, moved that the bill entitled "The Professional Engineering Regulatory Council Act, 2021" be read the First Time.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that the bill had been read the First Time.

(ii) The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, called upon the Minister of Works and Public Assets to proceed with the **Second Reading** of the bill.

Second Reading:

The Minister of Works and Public Assets, **Mr. Peter Bayuku Konteh**, moved that the bill entitled **"The Professional Engineering Regulatory Council Act, 2021"** be read the <u>Second Time</u>. He presented the objects and reasons of the bill to the House and again moved that the bill be read the <u>Second Time</u>.

Standing Order 37 - (Dilatory Motions):

The Leader of Opposition, Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District stood on S.O. 37 and moved a motion for the debate on the said bill to be postponed to a future date. The motion was seconded by the Acting Leader of Government Business, Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District and approved by the House.

7. Standing Order 23 – (Personal Explanations):

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:


- (i) Hon. Mohamed Billoh Shaw of Constituency 039, Falaba District reminded the House about the reduction of taxes on commodities like iron rod and cement which had not reflected in the market to date. He referred to a video making rounds on social media wherein the Minister of Trade and Industry stated that the price of cement should be between Le 85,000 to Le 95,000. The Honourable Member pleaded to Mr. Speaker to use his good office to ensure that the reduction done by the House (from 20% to 10%) should be reflected in the market.
- (ii) Hon. Ibrahim Kamara of Constituency 063, Karene District rose on Section (5) sub-section (2) (b) of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991) and recited the provision as quoted: "the security, peace and welfare of the people of Sierra Leone shall be the primary purpose and responsibility of Government, and to this end it shall be the duty of the Armed Forces, the Police, Public Officers and all security agents to protect and safeguard the people of Sierra Leone." He informed the House that some soldiers had been deployed in his Constituency, and that they had been posing social problems to his people in the various communities (taking their phones, motor bikes, benny seeds etc. from civilians). He said he had spoken with the relevant authorities but would want Mr. Speaker to use his office to intervene in the issue.
