- 1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Senior Table Clerk).
- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:50 am:

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:50 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Moses B. Jorkie of Constituency 091, Bonthe District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District** and approved by the House.

3. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 15th March, 2022: The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 15th March, 2022 was moved by Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District. It was seconded by Hon. Alice Jebbeh Kumabeh of Constituency 092, Bonthe District and adopted by the House.

4. Announcement by Mr. Speaker:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, again emphasized on the lateness of Hon. Members and referenced page 5 of the Votes and Proceedings for the 10th of March 2022 where he had earlier admonished the Whips to ensure that Hon. Members attended sittings on time. He stated that he would start using the media to express his dissatisfaction over the punctuality of Hon. Members.

The Whip of Opposition (Hon. Hassan A. Sesay of Constituency 050, Tonkolili District) apologized to Mr. Speaker on behalf of the House for the lateness of Hon. Members. He pleaded to Mr. Speaker for a meeting to be held in Committee Room One to discuss the issue of punctuality concerning Hon. Members.

The Acting Leader of Government Business (Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District) totally agreed with Mr. Speaker on the issue of punctuality relating to the commencement of sittings. He encouraged the whips on both sides of the aisle to ensure that Hon. Members attended parliamentary sittings on time.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, stated that he had listened to the plea made by the Whip of Opposition. He ordered that a meeting should be held with all Hon. Members on Wednesday the 16th of March 2022 at 12 noon in Committee Room One. He said that on the said meeting, he would keenly listen to the ways and means of improving the attendance of Hon. Members. He further said that if after the said meeting, no improvement on the attendance of Hon. Members was made; he would use the media to inform the public about their Members of Parliament.





5. Government Motion by the Minister of Trade and Industry

The Senior Table Clerk, Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston, called upon the Minister of Trade and Industry.

The Deputy Minister of Trade and Industry, **Madam Haja Isata Kamara**, moved a motion with the following words as quoted:

"Be it resolved: That This Honourable House hereby ratifies the following agreement which was laid on the Table of the House on Thursday 10th March, 2022."

Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone and Grafton Investment (SL) Limited Dated December 2021.

Mr. Speaker proposed the question for debate.

Mr. Speaker's Response to Hon. Lahai Marah's Submission:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, encouraged the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Water Resources to expeditiously hold a meeting with the Leadership of Parliament and that he should summon all Water Producing Companies to be in attendance.

The Deputy Minister of Trade and Industry, **Madam Haja Isata Kamara**, responded to the issues raised by Hon. Members and again moved the ratification of the motion.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Senior Table Clerk, Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston, pronounced that the motion had been ratified.





6. Bills:

(A) The Environment Protection Agency Act, 2021.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, called upon The Minister of Environment, Prof. Foday M. Jaward to proceed on the <u>Committee Stage</u>, of the said bill.

Committee Stage - The Mace was covered. The Wigs of Mr. Speaker and Table Clerks were taken off:

The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole House.

Amendment of Order Paper:

The Acting Leader of Government Business (Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District) moved a motion to amend the Order Paper for the House to first consider item 5 (b) – "The National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act, 2021" (to be read as 5 (a), and vice versa. The motion was seconded by Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District and approved by the House.

(A) The National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act, 2021.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, called upon The Minister of Environment, Prof. Foday M. Jaward to proceed on the <u>Committee Stage</u>, of the said bill.

Committee Stage - The Mace was covered. The Wigs of Mr. Speaker and Table Clerks were taken off:

The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole House.

(i) The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, pronounced that Parts 1, 2, 3 and 4, Clauses 1 to 18 stand part of the bill.

The Minister of Environment, **Prof. Foday Jaward**, moved that Parts 1, 2, 3 and 4, Clauses 1 to 18 stand part of the bill.

Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate. The debate started.

The Acting Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie**, noticed that the long title of the bill had been summarized and changed from the extant law. He moved a motion for the long title of the extant law to be sustained.

Mr. Speaker responded by establishing the difference of the long title of the extant law from the bill in question. He extended his advice to the House and more especially to Hon. Members of the Legislative Committee. He called upon the Minister of Environment to react.





7. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2) at 12:00 p.m.

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 12 noon was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013**, **Kenema District** for the proceedings to continue during lunch. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Sahr Charles of Constituency 028**, **Kono District** and approved by the House.

Continued proceedings.

Standing Order 57 – (Recommittal of Bill Reported from Select Committee):

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Segepoh S. Thomas of Constituency 089, Bonthe District) rose on S.O. 57 and moved a motion for the bill entitled "The Environment Protection Agency Act, 2021" to be recommitted to the Legislative Committee for further scrutiny. The motion was seconded by Hon. Sahr Charles of Constituency 028, Kono District.

Countered Motion by Hon. Daniel B. Koroma of Constituency 046, Koinadugu:

Pursuance to S.O. 51, **Hon. Daniel B. Koroma** moved a countered motion against the motion moved by **Hon. Segepoh S. Thomas**, but his countered motion was overruled by the House.

Mr. Speaker again asked for a Seconder to the motion moved by **Hon. Segepoh S. Thomas.** The motion was seconded by **Hon. Hassan A. Sesay of Constituency 050, Tonkolili District** and approved by the House.

Mr. Speaker's Declaration:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, declared that both bills should be recommitted to the Legislative Committee for thorough scrutiny.

The House resumed from the Committee Stage.

The mace was uncovered, and the wigs of Mr. Chairman and the Table Clerks were put on.

Mr. Speaker's Admonishment:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, extended his thanks and appreciations to the Deputy Speaker of Parliament for drawing his attention to the relevant provision quoted. He advised Hon. Members of the House and more especially Members of the Legislative Committee to decide in their own mind what would be in the best interest of the country when they would go to the Legislative hearing. He believed that it was the first time in the Fifth Parliament that they had recommitted work done by the Legislative Committee. He appealed to all Hon. Members that would be participating in the legislative hearing to uphold the overarching guideline of national interest.





8. Standing Order 23 – (Personal Explanations):

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:

- (i) **Hon. Sahr Charles of Constituency 028, Kono District** reminded the House about the issue of question time that Mr. Speaker had promised Hon. Members.
- (ii) Hon. Maada Afiju Kanja of Constituency 018, Kenema District informed the House about the damage that had been taking place on the forest at the peninsula. He said that for the past month, he had been seeing fire at night burning the forest from Sussex to Borboh and that if no action was taken, the fire would reach Guma Valley Dam.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, called upon the Minister of Environment (**Prof. Foday Jaward**) who was then in the chamber to take note of the submission made by **Hon. Maada Afiju Kanja**.

Adjournment:

Mr. Speaker adjourned the House to Thursday 17th March 2022 at 10:00 a.m. The House rose at 12:57 p.m.
