1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Senior Table Clerk).

2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:16 am:

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:16 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Hindolo Tennyson Sandy of Constituency 120, Western Urban District** and approved by the House.

3. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 24th March, 2022:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 24th March, 2022 was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Simeon Fefegula of Constituency 096, Moyamba District** and adopted by the House.

4. Announcement by Mr. Speaker

The Speaker, **Rt. Hon. Dr. Chernor Abass Bundu**, informed the House that he had two announcements to make. The first was that the bill which captured the welfare of Members of Parliament had made progress and that he was cautiously optimistic about the outcome because of the consultations that were on going.

Mr. Speaker also informed the House about his zest to transform the Sierra Leone Parliament to an e-Parliament to match the current trend of Parliaments around the world. He said technically, computers would be provided to every Member so that they would be able to access all relevant information in and out of Chamber. He also said he would consult with the Leadership on what should happen to the tablets that would be provided even though he was in favor that Members should own them as they own hard copies of documents. Mr. Speaker itemized the gadgets that Members would be in control of; the user name and passwords to access their electronic pigeon holes, a Lenovo M10 Tablet, Lenovo M10 Protective Cover and a Wi-Fi Modem that would aid them to access all information even in their remotest setting.

5. Swearing-in of Elected Members of Parliament (Third Schedule of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone)

Pursuance to Section 83 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No.6 of 1991), The Speaker **Rt. Hon. Dr. Chernor Abass Bundu** called upon the Clerk of Parliament (**Hon. Paran Umar Tarawally**) to administer the oath of Allegiance as set out in the Third Schedule of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991).





Administering of Oath by the Clerk of Parliament:

The Clerk of Parliament, Hon. Paran Umar Tarawally, invited the Leadership of Parliament to witness the process of administering the oath of Allegiance to the Hon. Members Designate as set out in The Third Schedule of The Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991).

Mr. Speaker's Felicitation:

The Speaker, **Rt. Hon. Dr. Chernor Abass Bundu** also welcomed the newly sworn in Members of Parliament and asked all to rise and observe a minute's silence in respect to the death of the mother of one of the newly sworn in Member of Parliament Hon. **Issa Oye Koroma**. He recited the following prayer as quoted "May the Almighty Allah Forgive the mistakes of the deceased and grant her eternal rest in his heavenly kingdom."

The Leader of Opposition, **Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District** rose on Section 5 sub-section 2(b) of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone, Act No.6 of 1991 and recited the said provision as quoted "The security, peace and welfare of the people of Sierra Leone shall be the primary purpose and responsibility of Government, and to this end it shall be the duty of the Armed Forces, the police, Public Officers and all Security agents to protect and safeguard the people of Sierra Leone". He





talked about the bushes around the peninsular that had been burnt by land grabbers and also the sale of the only State owned telecommunication, Sierratel to a company known as Senetel.

The Acting Leader of Government of Business, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082** encouraged the Chairman of the Committees on Environment and Lands to sit with the Leadership to discuss the way forward to address that issue. In response to the latter issue raised by the Leader of Opposition, he said that he expected the Government to do due diligence on the agreement of the sale of Sierratel.

Mr. Speaker's Response

Mr. Speaker agreed with both Leaders and gave consent for consultations to hold with the Leadership and that he wanted to see that the agreement would capture the concerns raised by the leaders.

6. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2) at 12:00 p.m.

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 12 noon was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** for the proceedings to continue during lunch. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Ishmail Sandy of Constituency 080, Bo District** and approved by the House.

Continued debate:

Bill: The Tobacco and Nicotine Control Act, 2021.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, called upon the Minister of Health and Sanitation to proceed with the **Introduction and First Reading of the bill**.

Introduction and First Reading

The Deputy Minister of Health and Sanitation, Mrs. Princess Dugba, moved that the bill entitled "The Tobacco and Nicotine Control Act, 2021" be read the <u>First Time</u>.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Francis Ernest Farma, pronounced that the bill had been read the First Time.

(ii) The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, called upon the Minister of Health and Sanitation to proceed with the **Second Reading** of the bill.





Second Reading:
