

- 1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Table Clerk).
- 2. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 14th December, 2021: The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 14th December, 2021 was moved by Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District. It was seconded by Hon. James Ozan Tholley of Constituency 054, Tonkolili District and adopted by the House with some amendments.

3. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, reminded Hon. Members about the issue of punctuality as one of their obligations. He implored all Hon. Members to honour and respect the essence of punctuality as part of their DNA of becoming a Hon. Member of Parliament.

4. Government Motion by The Minister of Lands, Housing and Country Planning:

The Table Clerk, **Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston**, called upon The Minister of Lands, Housing and C ountry Planning.

The Minister of Lands, Housing and Country Planning, **Dr. Turad Senessie**, moved the motion as follows.

"Be it resolved: That this Honourable House hereby ratifies the following agreements which were laid on the Table of the House on Thursday 28th October and Tuesday 14th December, 2021 Respectively:"

(A) Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone and LandReg (SL) Limited Government Support Agreement Relating to the Procurement of Biometric Property Registration Project on a Build, Operate and Transfer Basis, dated 26th July, 2021.

And

An Addendum Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone and Landreg (SL) Limited to Government Support Agreement Realting to the Procurement of Biometric Property Registration Project on a Build, Operate and Transfer Basis.

(B) Addendum to the Agreement between the Government of Sierra Leone and Landreg (SL) Limited.

The Minister of Lands, Housing and Country Planning, **Dr. Turad Senessie**, presented the motion to the House and moved its ratification.

The Minister of Lands, Housing and Country Planning, **Dr. Turad Senessie**, responded to the issues raised by Hon. Members and again moved the ratification of the motion.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote.

Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston, pronounced that the motion had been ratified.

5. The National Investment Board Act, 2021. By the Minister of Finance

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, called upon The Deputy Minister II of Finance to proceed on the Committee Stage of the bill.

Committee Stage:

The House resolved itself into Committee of the whole House.

The Mace was covered. The Wigs of Mr. Speaker and the Table Clerks were taken off:

(i) The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi,** pronounced that "Parts 1, 2 and 3, Clauses 1 to 27 stand part of the bill."

The Deputy Minister II of Finance, Mr. Sheku Fantamadi Bangura, moved that "Parts 1, 2 and 3, Clauses 1 to 27 stand part of the bill."

Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate.

The debate started, and amendments were made.





The Deputy Minister II of Finance, Mr. Sheku Fantamadi Bangura, again moved that "Parts 1, 2 and 3, Clauses 1 to 27 stand part of the bill as amended with the exception of clause 5."

Mr. Chairman put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, pronounced that "Parts 1, 2 and 3, Clauses 1 to 27 had formed part of the bill as amended with the exception of clause 5."

Hon. Abdul Karim Kamara of Constituency 059, Kambia District raised concerns over the two different testimonies of compensation made by Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin and Hon. P.C. Bai Kurr Kanagbaro Sanka III. He asked that the issue of compensations should be investigated by the House instead of leaving it under the carpet.

Mr. Chairman's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, ordered the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Works to conduct investigations on the said issues concerning the payment of compensations and report to the House accordingly.

6. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 12:00 p.m.

The motion for the suspension of S. O. 5 (2) at 12:00 noon was moved by Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District for the proceedings to continue during lunch. The motion was seconded by Hon. Dr. Mark Mahmoud Kalokoh of Constituency 034, Bombali District and approved by the House.

Continuation of Committee Stage.

(ii) The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, pronounced that "Parts 4 and 5, Clauses 28 to 37 stand part of the bill."

The Deputy Minister II of Finance, Mr. Sheku Fantamadi Bangura, moved that "Parts 4 and 5, Clauses 28 to 37 stand part of the bill."





Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate.

The debate started, and amendments were made.

The Deputy Minister II of Finance, Mr. Sheku Fantamadi Bangura, again moved that "Parts 4 and 5, Clauses 28 to 37 stand part of the bill as amended."

Mr. Chairman put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that "Parts 4 and 5, Clauses 28 to 37 had formed part of the bill as amended."

(iii) The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi,** pronounced that "Parts 6 and 7, Clauses 38 to 53 stand part of the bill."

The Deputy Minister II of Finance, Mr. Sheku Fantamadi Bangura, moved that "Parts 6 and 7, Clauses 38 to 53 stand part of the bill."

Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate.

The debate started, and amendments were made.

The Deputy Minister II of Finance, **Mr. Sheku Fantamadi Bangura**, again moved that "Parts 6 and 7, Clauses 38 to 53 stand part of the bill as amended."

Mr. Chairman put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that "Parts 6 and 7, Clauses 38 to 53 had formed part of the bill as amended."





Mr. Chairman's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed Hon. Members that the House would continue with the remaining clause 5 of the bill on Thursday 16th December, 2021 after he would have had the opportunity to make further consultations with the Leadership of Parliament and the promoters of the bill. He ordered the resumption of the House.

The House resumed from the Committee of the Whole House.

The Mace was uncovered. The Wigs of Mr. Speaker and the Table Clerks were put on.
