1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Senior Table Clerk).

2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:50 am:

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:50 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Nenneh Lebbie of Constituency 086, Bo District** and approved by the House.

3. The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 1st March, 2022:

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 1st March, 2022 was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Allieu Ibrahim Kamara of Constituency 122, Western Urban District** and adopted by the House as amended.

4. Announcement by Mr. Speaker:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House about the issue of attendance. He extended his congratulations to all Hon. Members that were punctual for that day's sitting and asked the House to acknowledge that, but he withheld his congratulations to those that were not punctual. He pleaded to all Hon. Members to take their duties more seriously. He said that they carried the trust of the nation and especially the trust of the members of their constituencies. He made mention of the whips and especially the Chief Whip of Government Business. He stated that he gave credit to the Whip of the Opposition more than he did to the Chief Whip of Government Business. He said that he yearned to see the day when both the Leader of Government Business and the Leader of Opposition would agree with him that the House should attach some form of penalty to the issue of lateness.

5. Amendment of Order Paper:

Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District) rose on S.O. 37 and moved a motion for the complete Committee Stage of the bill entitled "The Environment Protection Agency Act, 2021." to be postponed to a future date due to the laying-out ceremony of the late Hon. Cecil J. Hanson. The motion was seconded by Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District and approved by the House.

The House resumed from the Committee Stage.

The mace was uncovered, and the wigs of Mr. Chairman and the Table Clerks were put on.





9. Standing Order 23 – (Personal Explanations):

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:

- (i) **Hon. Nenneh Lebbie of Constituency 086, Bo District** informed the House about her participation on the celebrations of the International Women Day that took place on the 8th of March 2022. She said that the women of Bo District asked her to convey their message to the House through Mr. Speaker that they had a Communiqué as in respect to **The Gender Empowerment Act, 2021** that had been introduced to the House by The Minister of Gender and Children's Affairs (**Madam Manti Tarawalli**). She said that the women of Bo District wanted Mr. Speaker to add his voice to the aforementioned bill.
- (ii) **Hon. P.C. Bai Kurr Kanagbaro Sanka III of Tonkolili District** reminded the House about the happenings in the world more especially in Ukraine. He wanted to know about the things that the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone had done for Sierra Leonean students and residents in Ukraine.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, encouraged **Hon. P.C. Bai Kurr Kanagbaro Sanka III** to address a written letter to the Minister of Foreign Affairs (**Prof. David John Francis**) because he believed it was an appropriate question for the said Minister to elicit information from the Sierra Leonean Embassy in Moscow.

(iii) Hon. Daniel B. Koroma of Constituency 046, Koinadugu District responded to the submission made by Hon. Nenneh Lebbie. He advised that the said communiqué mentioned by Hon. Nenneh Lebbie should be served to all Hon. Members. He said that the preview of the content of the communiqué would empower Hon. Members.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House about his address made to the Executive Committee of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association – African Region on the 8th of March 2022 in Accra concerning the empowerment of women. He said that he believed that charity should begin at home. He stated that instead of Parliament always looking up to the Executive to empower women, Parliament itself should begin the process of empowering women within its own institution.
