6. Bill: The National Investment Board Act, 2021.

Committee Stage - The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole House.

The Mace was covered. The Wigs of Mr. Speaker and the Table Clerks were taken off:

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, called upon The Minister of Finance to proceed on the **Committee Stage** of the bill.

The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that Clause 5 stand part of the bill.

The Deputy Minister of Finance I, **Mr. Sheku Fantamadi Bangura**, moved that Clause 5 stand part of the bill.

Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate.

The debate started, and some amendments were made.

The Deputy Minister of Finance I, **Mr. Sheku Fantamadi Bangura**, again moved that clause 5 stand part of the bill as amended.

Mr. Chairman put the question for vote.

"All those in favour, say Aye."

"All those against, say Nay."

Through collection of voices, Mr. Chairman declared that the Ayes had it.





The Table Clerk, Mr. Prince Oviasuyi, pronounced that Clause 5 had formed part of the bill as amended.

The House resumed from the Committee Stage.

The Mace was uncovered. The wigs of Mr. Speaker and the Table Clerks were put on.

7. Standing Order 23 – (Personal Explanations):

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:

(i) Hon. Dr. Mark Mahmoud Kalokoh of Constituency 032, Bombali District again reminded the House about the termination of the Ceramic Bauxite Mining Company and the Report of the Committee on Mines and Mineral Resources that should be debated in order to avoid further litigation from mining Companies.

Mr. Speaker's Response

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Chernor Abass Bundu**, again assured the Hon. Member that the report would be surely debated and advised him to hold on to his view so that it would be looked into in tandem with the report when it would make its way on the Order Paper.

(ii) Hon. Saa Emerson Lamina of Constituency 030, Kono District informed the House about the monopoly of the usage of the Peppel Land for the export of their minerals. He said the issue was an emergency one, and it was not factored in the report that was laid.

The Leader of Opposition (Hon. Chernor R. M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban) advised that the said debate of the report should be expedited so that all the issues would be discussed in details.

The Leader of Government Business (Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District) added that the issue raised by the Hon. Member was not in the report, but he suggested that an addendum should be done.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Chernor Abass Bundu**, directed that **Hon. Saa Emerson Lamina** should prepare a formal addendum report about the issue.





(iii) Hon. Ishmail Sama Sandy of Constituency 080, Bo District reported to the House about a challenging issue in the Tikonkoh Health Center. He said he had made series of complaints and had also sent an official letter to the Minster of Health and Sanitations about the lack of beds in wards and the labour room of the aforementioned health center. He complained that the beds in the wards were broken, and the center was in a bad shape for both women and children. He proposed that the Parliamentary Committee on Health and Sanitations should summon officials from the Ministry of Health and Sanitations so that they would address the issue.
