- 1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Table Clerk).
- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:40 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S. O. 5 (2) at 10:40 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Neneh Lebbie of Constituency 086, Bo District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Tennyson Hindolo Sandy of Constituency 120, Western Urban District** and approved by the House.

### 3. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Leader of Government Business, Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by replacing the Seconder of the motion (Motion of Thanks to His Excellency the President Julius Maada Bio), Hon. Abdul S. Marray-Conteh with Hon. Ishmail Sama Sandy. The motion was seconded by Hon. Josephine Makieu of Constituency 014, Kenema District and approved by the House.

### 4. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that that day's sitting was a special one, and that the regular attendees for the previous sittings would be the first to catch his eyes and be recognized if they would stand up to make a contribution. He said that the records would not only be from the attendance of Hon. Members for that day's sitting but from previous sittings as well.

He also drew the attention of all Hon. Members to the provisions of Standing Order (38) Paragraphs (1) & (3). He recited paragraph (1) of S.O. 38 as quoted: "Subject to paragraph (2) of this Order, no member shall be entitled to address the House or a Committee of the Whole House for more than thirty minutes on any subject; Provided that the mover of a substantive motion shall be entitled to forty-five minutes for his opening speech."

He also recited paragraph (3) of S.O. 38 as quoted "This Order shall not apply to speeches made during the debate on the Presidential Address to Parliament and the debate on the Second reading of the annual Appropriation Bill; Provided that in debates limited to specific allotted days the Speaker may determine and allocate the time of each contribution, such as to accommodate the participation of all those who wish to speak. And the Fifth day of the five days allotted to the debate on the Motion of Thanks to His Excellency the President for his Address to Parliament on the occasion of the State Opening of Parliament shall, pursuant to subsection (2) of Section 107 of the Constitution, be devoted to Ministerial responses to the issues raised by Members on government policies contained in the speech."

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, further drew the attention of Hon. Members to Standing Order (43) Paragraphs (1) & (10). He recited Paragraph (1) of S.O. (43) as quoted: "**Mr. Speaker**, **or the Chairman**, having called the attention of the House, or of the Committee, to the conduct of a Member who persists in irrelevance, or tedious repetition, either on his own argument, or on the arguments used by other Members in debate, may direct him to discontinue his speech."





He also recited Paragraph (10) of S.O. (43) "In exercise of the parliamentary privilege of freedom of speech and debate in the House, which is necessarily constitutively unassailable outside Parliament, Members shall accurately address the empirically verifiable, avoiding destructive conjectures or speculations, and shall conduct themselves honourably and responsibly with an eye to the self-regulatory constitutional provisions in Section 97 and subsections (2)(3)(4) and (5) of Section 99 of the Constitution."
