- 1. Prayers were read by Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Table Clerk).
- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 10:30 a.m.

The motion for the suspension of S. O. 5 (2) at 10:30 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Alice Jebbeh Kumabeh of Constituency 092, Bonthe District** and approved by the House.

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that the Record of Votes and Proceedings was not ready because of some technical challenges with the printers. He stated that the Records of Votes and Proceedings would be dealt with cumulatively when they would be readily available.

Hon. Daniel B. Koroma of Constituency 046, Koinadugu District raised concern over the availability of the Records of Votes and Proceedings in previous sittings especially on the debate of the Motion of Thanks to His Excellency the President Julius Maada Bio. He blamed the administration for not providing ways to fix the problem. He also said that there were matters recorded in the document that would be useful to Hon. Members during proceedings.

Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District raised concern over the production of the Hansards. He reported that Hon Members had not received copies of the Hansards over the past six months. He therefore drew the attention of the department responsible to ensure the timely production of the document.

### Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, directed that the Table Clerks should ensure that all the cumulative backlog of Records of Votes and Proceedings should be made available by the next adjourned date. He also encouraged the department responsible for the production of the Hansards to be timely with its production of said document.

### 3. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House about a publication from the Institute of Governance Reform (I.G.R.) He said the report was important because it captured the analysis on the attendance of Hon. Members. He also said that he would have loved to see the report captured the issues of punctuality and attendance, but the author had not captured that.

**Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District** stated that Hon. Members had other functions to perform apart from plenary sittings and therefore questioned the parameters that were used by the author of that report to put together his findings. He therefore proposed that the author should be invited to Parliament to justify his report.





Hon. Daniel B. Koroma of Constituency 046, Koinadugu District supported the proposition of Hon. Dickson M. Rogers and further suggested that since the report had been published worldwide, Hon. Members should move a motion to invite the author to Parliament to explain to Hon Members about the method he used to put his report together. He said the author went further to mention the best debaters without even consulting the Whips in Parliament. He further suggested that the report should be made available and distributed in the pigeon holes of all Hon. Members.

**Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District** said that although the report seemed biased, he encouraged Hon. Members to accept it with good faith and do the needful.

**Hon. Sahr Charles of Constituency 028, Kono District** added that the report was biased. He said his name was mentioned as a regular debater while he had not been given the opportunity to debate regularly.

**Hon. P.C. Haja Fatmata Bintu Meama Kajue** reported that she had always been a regular attendee Paramount Chief in Parliamentary Sittings but the report did not capture that and deliberately omitted her contribution.

Hon. Ibrahim Tawa Conteh of Constituency 132, Western Urban District joined his colleague Hon. Members to criticize the report. He claimed that the period that the report covered was a very busy period in Parliament during which almost all Members of Parliament were attending Parliament regularly because of the workload both in plenary and in their respective Committees.

### Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, stated that there seemed to be inconsistencies from the IGR Report based on contributions made by Hon. Members. He encouraged all Hon. Members to read the said report so that Parliament would take a position on the issue from an informed point against the next adjourned date. He said he believed that the report was a premature publication as the issue of attendance was provided for in the Standing Orders of Parliament.
