1. Prayers were read by Mr. Edward Sahr Lebbie (Table Clerk).

2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2):

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5 (2) at 11:17 a.m. was moved by the Chief Whip of Government Business, Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by the Deputy Chief Whip of Government Business, Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District, and approved by the House.

3. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Leader of Government Business, Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by incorporating a new Item that should be numbered item (IV) – (Laying of Papers) and the initial item (IV) Government Motion became item (V). The motion was seconded by the Deputy Leader of Government Business, Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District and approved by the House.

4. Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Monday 10th May, 2021:

The motion for the adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for **Monday 10th May, 2021** was moved by **Hon. Moses B. Jorkie of Constituency 091, Bonthe District.** It was seconded by **Hon. Mohamed Billoh Shaw of Constituency 039, Falaba District** and adopted by the House with an amendment.

5. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, informed the House that he had again been advised that the State Opening of Parliament for the Fourth Session of the Fifth Parliament of the Second Republic would be held in the Chamber of the Parliament of Sierra Leone on Tuesday 18th May 2021. He stated that he would go by the said advice, and he prayed and hoped that they were not mistaking.

6. Laying of Papers:

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Edward S. Lebbie**, called upon **The Leader of Government Business** to lay the Papers that were itemized on the Order Paper.

Papers laid by the Leader of Government Business.

The Leader of Government Business, Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District, laid

Hon. Aaron Aruna Koroma of Constituency 048, Tonkolili District rose on Standing Order 25 in tandem with Section 170 (7) of the **Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991)** and moved a motion that Parliament should debate the Papers laid by the Leader of Government before its period of maturity (21 days).

The Leader of Government Business, Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District informed the House that a representative from the National Revenue Authority (NRA) would be invited to the House to expatiate on the said documents before the expiration of 21 days.

The Leader of Opposition, **Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District** agreed with the point made by the Leader of Government Business. He informed the House that they had no intention of going against the said documents but rather admonish that an expert be invited to educate Honourable Members of Parliament on the new tax structures.

7. (a) Government Motion by the Minister of Mines and Mineral Resources:

Amendment Deed Relating to the Build-Operate-Transfer Agreement for the Construction, Financing and Concession of Freetown International Airport between The State of the Republic of Sierra Leone and Summa Airports (SL) Limited.

The Minister of Transport and Aviation, **Mr. Rex Bonapha**, presented the motion to the House and moved its ratification.





Mr. Speaker proposed the question for debate.

The Minister of Transport and Aviation, **Mr. Rex Bonapha**, responded to the issues raised by Honourable Members and again moved for its ratification.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote. "All those in favour, say Aye." "All those against, say Nay." Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Edward S. Lebbie**, pronounced that the Government Motion by the Minister of Transport and Aviation had been ratified.

8. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanations):

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:

- (i) The Leader of Opposition, Hon. Chernor R. M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District informed the House about the death of the son of Hon. Amadu Kanu of Constituency 093, Moyamba District. He also informed the House about the death of the mother of Hon. Abubakarr Fofanah of Constituency 107, Western Rural District.
- (ii) The Deputy Leader of Government Business, Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District also informed the House about the death of the father of Hon. Allieu Ibrahim Kamara of Constituency 122, Western Urban District.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, responded by asking all to rise and observe a minute of silence in honour of their memory. He recited the following prayer as quoted: "May The Almighty God forgive the mistakes of the faithful departed and grant their gentle souls eternal rest in His heavenly Kingdom and grant the families of the deceased the fortitude to bear the grievous loss they have suffered."





- (iii) Hon. Catherine Zainab Tarawally of Constituency 037, Bombali District informed the House about her concerns over the Sierra Leone Road Safety Authority (SLRSA) preferential contract that they wanted to give to Auto-Specs Company over the production of Number Plates against the three companies (Sara Trading Company, Bihaq and International Associated Services "IAS") that had been responsible for producing number plates. She reminded the House about the ratification of the Local Content Policy. She also pleaded to Mr. Speaker to use his good office to establish a Special Committee or instruct the Chairman responsible for Transport to do the needful.
- (iv) Hon. Ambrose Maada Lebby of Constituency 083, Bo District, Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Transport and Aviation, stated that he had carefully listened to the concerns raised by Hon. Catherine Zainab Tarawally. He assured the House that the Parliamentary Committee on Transport and Aviation would investigate the issue and revert to the House accordingly.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, ordered the Chairman of the said Committee to summon the key players (**SLRSA**, **Sara Trading Company**, **Bihaq I.A.S.**, **NPPA** and **the Ministry of Transport and Aviation**) to examine the said issue and report to the House within 2 weeks.

- (v) Hon. Ibrahim Ben Kargbo of Constituency 034, Bombali District reminded the House about a Private Member's motion that he moved during the Third Session of which was seconded by Hon. Amadu Kanu of Constituency 093, Moyamba District for the Local Content Policy to be discussed by Parliament. He said that he was concerned that the Third Session was about to elapse, and that the motion had never seen the light of day. He therefore declared his intention of withdrawing the said motion and moving it again during the Fourth Session of the Fifth Parliament.
- (vi) **Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District** stood to remind the House that there's a Local content Act in existence which caters for the welfare of citizens and so there would be no need for another motion to be moved.
- (vii) Hon. Dr. Unpha Sorie Gbassay Koroma of constituency 114, Western Urban notified the House about the ongoing NCRA registration and verification process. He emphasized the importance of the process and called on the House for an extension of time so that all Sierra Leoneans could fully partake in the process, as the time stated for its completion was short, and its purpose could not be fully achieved.





Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, directed the Deputy Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District** to lead the Internal Affairs Committee to invite the National Civil Registration Authority (NCRA) to a Committee meeting in order for them to revisit their timetable and make a very critical review of their program of work to enable them to capture the details of every Sierra Leonean and Non Sierra Leonean.

Hon. James Ozan Tholley of Constituency 054, Tonkolili District informed the House about the health status of people in the city of Freetown. He said that the dump at Ferry Junction had been a threat for the people in that community. He also informed the House about the deplorable condition of the emergency ward in the Connaught Hospital. He further informed the House about a relative of his whose son fell from a mango tree. He told the House that the boy had sustained spinal injuries of which surgery of that nature could not be performed in Sierra Leone.

Hon. Foday Mario Kamara of Constituency 057, Kambia District informed the House about the delay in the construction of the road in **Billeh-Samu Chiefdom**. He said that he was deeply concerned that the road was still far from completion as only 20% of the work had been done. He feared that the rains had started, and that the road would not be accessible for vehicles to ply. He, therefore, asked that the House look into that concern.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, ordered that the Committee on Works look into the concerns raised by **Hon. Foday Mario Kamara of Constituency 057, Kambia District.**
