Standing Order 34 – (Raising of Point of Order):

The Leader of Opposition, **Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District**, informed the House that the last change of currency in Sierra Leone was in 1964. He submitted that a direct engagement by the Minister of Finance together with his technical staff should be held with Hon. Members so that Hon. Members would become well informed and knowledgeable about the redenomination of the “Leone,” and Hon. Members in turn would be knowledgeable enough to cascade the relevant information to their various constituencies. He demanded for the early presentation of the Fiscal Strategy Statement to the House. He stated that the Fiscal Strategy Statement (FSS) should be debated by the House.

Response by the Leader of Government Business:

The Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma**, assured the House that the Fiscal Strategy Statement would be debated. He stated that Monday 22nd November 2021 should be an appropriate day for the direct engagement with the Minister of Finance together with his technical staff and Hon. Members.
