#### The House met at 12:03 a.m. The Rt. Hon. Speaker, Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu in the Chair

### I. ATTENDANCE:

- 1. Prayers were read by Mr. Ismaila Kabba (Table Clerk).
- 2. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2)

The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5 (2) at 12:03 P.m. was moved by **Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Mohamed Billoh Shaw of Constituency 039, Falaba District** and approved by the House.

#### 3. Amendment of Order Paper:

The Leader of Government Business, Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by expunging Item (V) – (Government Motion by the Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation) and Item (VI) – (The Bill entitled The Cybercrime Act, 2020). The motion was seconded by the Deputy Leader of Government Business, Hon. Bashiru Silikie of Constituency 082, Bo District and approved by the House.

### 4. Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2021:

The motion for the adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for **Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> April, 2021** was moved by **Hon. Ishmail S. Sandy of Constituency 080, Bo District.** It was seconded by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 081, Bo District** and adopted by the House with an amendment.

### 5. Mr. Speaker's Announcement:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, Informed the House about State Opening of Parliament that would take place as schedule but it was still uncertain whether it would be held in its usual place. He therefore suggested that the Leaders of the different political parties to join him in taking a tour to see the progress of the ongoing work so that they would be in position to inform their members accordingly.

- (ii) Letter of Agreement Transition Support Facility (TSF) Enhancing Efficiency and Sustainability of Artisanal and Small-Scale Miming Through Climate Smart Actions between the Republic of Sierra Leone and the African Development Fund.
- (iii) Supplemental Agreement to the Loan Agreement Signed on 12/05/1433H (04/04/2012G) between the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone and Islamic Development Bank (ISDB) Concerning the Construction of Pendembu-Kailahun Road Project in the Amount of USS 10,000,000.
- (iv) Financing Agreement on the Freetown Wash and Aquatic Environment Revamping Project between the Republic of Sierra Leone and the Islamic Development Bank Comprising of the Following:
- (a) Agency Agreement Installment Financing) between the Republic of Sierra Leone and the Islamic Development Bank- Freetown Wash and Aquatic Environment Revamping Project in an Amount of USS 40.0 Million.
- (b) Framework Agreement (Installment Sale Financing) between the Republic of Sierra Leone and the Islamic Development Bank – Freetown Wash and Aquatic Environment Revamping Project in an amount of US\$ 40,000,000.
- (v) Loan Agreement Construction of Tikonko Kpetemba –Mattru Jong Road Project Lot 1: Kpetemba – Mattru Jong between the Republic of Sierra Leone and The Arab Bank for Economic Development in Africa (BADEA) in an amount of US\$ 40,000,000.
