1. Prayers were read by *Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Table Clerk)*.

2. **The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 21st December, 2021:**

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Tuesday 21st December, 2021 was moved by **Hon. Sahr Charles of Constituency 028, Kono District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Moses Andrew Edwin of Constituency 090, Bonthe District** and adopted by the House.

3. **Mr. Speaker's Announcement:**

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, sadly announced the demise of two sitting Hon. Members; **Hon. Ahmed Samba Turay representing Constituency 073, Port Loko District** and **Hon. Aloysious Bockarie Ansumana representing Constituency 005, Kailahun District**. He also informed the House that a former Hon. Paramount Chief Member of Parliament who was from **Kono District** was terminally ill and admitted at a hospital in Ghana. Furthermore, he informed the House about the death of a former Hon. Member of Parliament, **Hon. Alhaji Ansumana Jaia Kaikai** who had passed away and was to be laid at the State Hall of Parliament immediately after that day's sitting.

Mr. Speaker, therefore, asked the House to stand and observe a minute of silence. He recited the following prayer as quoted: **"May Allah Almighty forgive them for any mistake they may have committed on earth and accept their souls and grant them eternal rest in his heavenly kingdom, Amen"**. He said that Hon. Members of Parliament should be in full attendance at the laying-out ceremony of the late **Hon. Alhaji Ansumana Jaia Kaikai** that was scheduled to take place after that day's sitting.

Finally, Mr. Speaker admonished all Hon. Members to devoid from all the bad habits of 2021 in the New Year of 2022 especially the habit of lateness. He said he would continue to pray that all Hon. Members continue to recognize the responsibilities conferred on them.

- (iii) The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis Ernest Farma**, called upon The Minister of Environment to proceed on the Committee Stage of the bill.

Committee Stage - The Mace was covered. The Wigs of Mr. Chairman and the Table Clerks were taken off:

The House resolved itself into Committee of the Whole House.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Francis E. Farma**, pronounced that Clauses 1 & 2 stand part of the bill.

The Minister of Environment, **Professor Foday Jaward**, moved that clauses 1 & 2 stand part of the bill.

**Mr. Chairman proposed the question for debate.
The debate started, and amendments were made.**

The Minister of Environment, **Professor Foday Jaward**, again moved that Clauses 1 & 2 stand part of the bill as amended.

Report Stage:

The Minister of Environment, **Professor Foday Jaward**, reported to the House that the bill entitled: **“The Forestry (Amendment) Act, 2022**, had gone through Committee of the whole House with some amendments made.

Third Reading:
