2. **Amendment of Order Paper.**

He also informed the House that a post mortem was done on the body of the deceased on the 27th of October, 2021 and that the cause of her death was due to the following reasons: fracture, strangulation, injuries on her body, blunted face and suffering from severe physical assaults upon which the autopsy result was contrary to the cause of death stated by Dr. Shuman Hospital. He pleaded with Mr. Speaker and especially the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Health to engage authorities to investigate further and ascertain the cause of death.

The Leader of Government Business (Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District) moved a motion that the Parliamentary Committees on Health and Human Rights should conduct a parliamentary investigation on the said case and report to the House within fourteen days.
