1. Prayers were read by *Mrs. Fatmata Bintu Weston (Table Clerk)*.

2. **Amendment of Order Paper:**

The Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District**, moved a motion to amend the Order Paper by replacing **Hon. Chernor R.M. Bah** as the initial proposer of the Private Member's Motion with **Hon. Abdul Kargbo**. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Aaron Aruna Koroma** and approved by the House.

3. **The Adoption of The Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2021:**

The motion for the adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for **Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2021** was moved by **Hon. Ishmail Sama Sandy of Constituency 080, Bo District**. It was seconded by **Hon. Simeon Fefegula of Constituency 096, Moyamba District** and adopted by the House with the exception of the submission made by the Leader of Opposition on S.O. 23 for clarification.

4. **Mr. Speaker's Announcements:**

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu** emphasized his dissatisfaction on the punctuality of Hon. Members and stated that he would not get tired of reminding Hon. Members of their obligations. He said that he would continue repeating the said announcement until the House would agree to adopt sanctions against lateness. He stated that he was hoping that the Whips on both sides of the aisle would have consulted and imposed sanctions or failing which, he would take that on himself.

The Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019, Kenema District** pleaded on behalf of his colleague Hon. Members that some were coming from their respective constituencies.

The Whip of the Opposition, **Hon. Hassan A. Sesay of Constituency 050, Tonkolili District** reassured the Speaker that he would put in all efforts along with the Chief Whip to maintain punctuality in the House. He pleaded with Mr. Speaker over the decision of imposing sanctions.

The Chief Whip of Government Business, **Hon. Dickson M. Rogers of Constituency 100, Pujehun District** also pleaded on behalf of his colleague Hon. Members. He said that the ongoing census was also a reason for the absenteeism of most Hon. Members on that day's sitting because most of them were in their constituencies.

Mr. Speaker's Response:

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, commended the efforts made by both whips on both sides of the aisle, but he stated that their efforts were not good enough to maintain the punctuality of Hon. Members' attendance.

**Hon. Daniel B. The Proposer, **Hon. Abdul Kargbo of Constituency 077, Port Loko District**, moved the motion as follows.

**“Be it resolved: That this Honourable House hereby debates the Following Statutory Instrument:**

**The Bank of Sierra Leone Act No. 5 of 2019.**

**Redenomination of the Leone (Characteristics) Regulations, 2021.**

**Statutory Instrument No. 14 of 2021.**

As the Proposer, **Hon. Abdul Kargbo of Constituency 077, Port Loko District** was explaining the reasons and memorandum of objects of the statutory instrument, he was objected by the Leader of Government Business with a Point of Order.

**Standing Order 34 (Raising of Point of Order):**

The Leader of Government Business, **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019**, stated that he was expecting the Proposer to come with clear indication of the motion in line with Section 170 (7) of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991). He demanded for the essence of the motion.

**Mr. Speaker’s Response:**

The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, agreed with the Leader of Government Business and demanded for the objectives of the motion in line with Section 170 (7) of the Constitution of Sierra Leone. He stated that the said statutory instrument had matured into law. He ruled that the Private Member’s Motion be expunged from the Order Paper because S.O. 25 (2) was not observed. He recited S.O. 25 (3a) as quoted: “If Mr. Speaker is of the opinion that any notice of motion which has been received by the Clerk infringes the provisions of any Standing Orders or is in any other way out of order, he may direct: (a) that the member concerned be informed that the notice of motion is out of order.”

**7. Bill: The Allied Health Professions Act, 2021. By the Minister of Health and Sanitation.**

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Ismaila Kabba**, called upon The Deputy Minister of Health and Sanitation to proceed with the Committee Stage of the bill.
