



## 4. Paper Laid:

## The Leader of Government Business:

The Leader of Government Business Hon. Sidie M. Tunis of Constituency 101, Pujehun District laid the following paper:

In accordance with Section 118, Sub-Section 7 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone Act No. 6 of 1991:

Gift of Medical Items Donated by Medicine Sans Frontiers to the Parliament of Sierra Leone.

Section 118 (7): Hon. Daniel B. Koroma of Constituency 046, Koinadugu District rose on section 118 (7) of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991) and reminded the House about the gift (rice) that was given to the Government of Sierra Leone from the Government of the People's Republic of China. ## 9. Standing Order 51(1) – Committal of Bills:

Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma of Constituency 019 Kenema District rose on S.O. 51(1) and moved a motion for the bill entitled: The National Disaster Management Agency Act, 2020 to be committed to the Legislative Committee. The motion was seconded by Hon. Daniel B. Koroma of Constituency 046, Koinadugu District and approved by the House.

## **Statement by Mr. Speaker:**

Mr. Speaker drew the attention of Hon. Members to page 8 of the Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2020 to a matter of which reference was made with regards the Public Notice by the Director General of the National Civil Registration Authority (NCRA). The Hon. Speaker, then, requested that all Hon. Members should retire to Committee Room No. 1 to deliberate on the matter at 3:15 p.m. after the plenary sitting.





## 10. Standing Order 23 - Personal Explanations:

The Following Honourable Member stood on S.O. 23:

1. Hon. Abdul Kargbo of Constituency 077, Port Loko District: The Hon. Member quoted Section 15 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991) and specifically laid emphasis on (b) as it reads "Whereas every person in Sierra Leone is entitled to the fundamental human rights and freedoms of the individual, that is to say, has the right, whatever his race, tribe, place of origin, political opinion, colour, creed or sex, but subject to respect for the rights and freedoms of others and for the public interest, to each and all of the following— (b) Freedom of conscience, of expression and of assembly and association;"

He reminded the House that there were demonstrators at the precincts of Parliament the previous week with regards the issue of passport of which no arrest was made. He then reported a similar assemblage which led to the arrest of Mr. Thomas Moore Conteh (a civil society activist) along with some students of the Limkomkwing University who had expressed their resentments on issues which had been affecting their existence for a while without attention. He questioned why no arrest was made under the same atmosphere during the previous demonstrations at Parliament, State House and Immigration.

The Hon. Member drew the attention of the House to the constitution which he said does not segregate between sex, race, tribe etc., with respect to rights and freedoms.

**Hon. Hindolo M. Gevao of Constituency 003, Kailahun District**: The Hon. Member referred the House to the provision below that Section to which reference was made by Hon. Abdul Kargbo as it reads "the subsequent section of this chapter shall have effect for the purpose of affording protection to the aforesaid rights and freedoms, subject to such limitations of that protection as are contained in those provisions, being limitations designed to ensure that the enjoyment of the said rights and freedoms by any individual does not prejudice the rights and freedoms of others, or the public interest."

## Hon. Chernor R. M. Bah of Constituency 126, Western Urban District (Leader of the Opposition):

The Leader of the Opposition pointed out that Hon. Abdul Kargbo only brought the information to the attention of the House and that every Member had the right to do so. He also said that "National issues are national issues, and Hon. Members of Parliament should not attach all information to politics." He admonished Hon. Members to respect the rules of Parliament and allow the procedure to be conducted accordingly.





## Mr. Speaker's Response:

Mr. Speaker admonished Hon. Members to ensure that they would always keep within the parameters of Standing Order 23. He appealed to Hon. Members to always investigate issues before they could make their submissions to Parliament.
