IX. STANDING ORDER 23 (PERSONAL EXPLANATION)

1. **Hassan A. Sesay (Const. 050 – Tonkolili Dist.)** – Drew the attention of the House to a press release that was made by the American Embassy about the inability of the Sierra Leone Police to provide adequate security for the people of Sierra Leone. He informed the House about a street violence that occurred on the 5th of December 2018, between students of the Government Model Secondary school and Sierra Leone Muslim Congress Secondary School after a football match, which resulted to the involvement of the Military Police (MACP) as the Police force could not handle the situation. The Honourable Member expressed his disappointment and felt demoralized that the Sierra Leone Police Force was indicted by the American Embassy. He advised that the security forces come together (MACP) to provide adequate security for the people of Sierra Leone during the festive season and for school going children to know their responsibilities. He concluded by saying that peace and stability enhances the flow of a healthy economy which should not be undermined.

RESPONSE BY MR. SPEAKER

Mr. Speaker expressed concern over the issue raised by **Hon. Hassan A. Sesay** by saying that it is not a matter that should be treated with levity. The Hon. Speaker proposed that the House deliberate on the issue of violence on the *“street especially amongst young people and how it can be contained”*, on Wednesday, 12th December, 2018 and ordered the Clerk of Parliament to issue a letter to the Security Forces and the Civil Society to witness the deliberation.

2. **Hon. Hindolo Moiwo Gevao (Const. 003 – Kailahun Dist.)** – Expressed dissatisfaction with the deplorable sanitary condition of the toilets and the lack of water in Parliament, which he said needs immediate attention. He further expressed dissatisfaction with the company responsible for cleaning Parliament due to poor hygienic conditions and suggested that their contract be terminated.
3. **Josephine Makieu (Const. 014 – Kenema Dist.)** – That fully loaded juggernauts plying the route from Kondoma to Kenema with timber had been causing serious damage to the road to the extent that she had to hire a caterpillar do some maintenance on the damaged road. She called on Government to look into the matter with urgency. She also informed Hon. Members that Kenema city will host a cocoa show from 12th to 16th December, 2018 and extended an invitation to all.
