1. Mr. Speaker adjourned the House to Thursday 7th November 2024 at 10:00 a.m.
2. **Prayers were read by Mr. Gilbert Bosco N'habay (Deputy Clerk of Parliament).**
3. **Suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:35 a.m.**
The motion for the suspension of S.O. 5(2) at 10:35 a.m. was moved by **Hon. Nenneh Lebbie** from **Bo District** for the commencement of proceedings. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Abdul Karim Bangura** from **Karene District** and approved by the House.
4. The Majority Leader **Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma** called on Mr. Speaker to invoke section 94(1) of the Sierra Leone Constitution 1991, (Act NO. 6 of 1991) to allow the business of the House to continue despite his earlier adjournment.

11. Standing Order 71 (2) (Special Select Committee):

Mr. Speaker nominated **Hon. Boston Munda** as Chairman of the Special Select Committee to investigate Orange S/L and was approved by the House.

12. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanation):

Hon. Mustapha Sellu from **Moyamba District**, stood on SO 23 and brought to the attention of the House an uncomfortable traffic along the Goderich highway from 7 Battalion to Metchem that is mostly caused by traders and pedestrians, with Police officers present in the scene during the morning and evening hours. He asked the House to call on the appropriate authorities to take necessary action in order to solve the problem. He also commended Mr. Speaker for the good work of his administration for raising the standard of the institution, and pleaded that the administration takes into account the deplorable condition of the flags at the Forecourt of Parliament. He also pleaded with Mr. Speaker to address the issue of consumables in the toilets as the toilets are now clean but there are no consumables.

Mr. Speaker responded by giving reasons to the issues raised by the Honourable Member. He stated that the reason was whenever consumables were been put in the toilets, they would get missing. He asked that people should reframe from doing such. He further stated that they would engage the Facility people and work on the issue of the flags at the Forecourt, and also engage numbers of sectors such as the Traders Union, Police etc. in order to address the issue regarding the traffic along the Goderich highway.
