The Minister of Youth Affairs, **Mr. Mohamed Orman Bangura**, moved that the bill be read the Third Time and passed into law.

Mr. Speaker put the question for vote. "All those in favour, say Aye." "All those against, say Nay."

## Through collection of voices, Mr. Speaker declared that the Ayes had it.

The Table Clerk, **Mr. Prince Oviasuyi**, pronounced that the bill entitled: **"The National Youth Commission (Amendment) Act, 2024"** had been read the Third Time and passed into law.
