- 4. Swearing-in of Elected Member of Parliament Based on the Third Schedule of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No. 6 of 1991):





The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, stated that in conformity with the certificate of election received from the Electoral Commission for Sierra Leone (ECSL), he, thereby, declared that the following had been duly elected as a Member of Parliament of the Republic of Sierra Leone: (**Hon. Alfred A. Thompson**). Pursuant to Section 83 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No 6 of 1991) in tandem with Standing Order 1 A of the Parliament of Sierra Leone, The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, called upon the Clerk of Parliament to administer the oath of office as established in the Third Schedule of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone.

#### **Administering of Oath of Allegiance:**

Before administering the oath of office, The Clerk of Parliament (Hon. Paran Umar Tarawally) invited the Leadership of the House to join him in administering the oath of office. Mr. Clerk called upon the newly elected Member of Parliament (Hon. Alfred A. Thompson) and administered the "Oath of Office" as established in the Third Schedule of the 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone as quoted: "I ... do hereby (in the name of God swear) that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the Republic of Sierra Leone as by law established, that I will uphold and defend the Constitution of Sierra Leone, and that I will faithfully and conscientiously discharge the duties of a Member of Parliament. (So help me God.)" Having subscribed the oath of office and appended his signature on the Oath Book, Mr. Clerk presented the newly elected Member of Parliament with a package that contained: (The 1991 Constitution of Sierra Leone; The Standing Orders of Parliament; The Parliament Act, 2023 and The Parliamentary Prayers).

### Mr. Speaker's Welcome Statement:

On behalf of the entire House, The Rt. Hon. Speaker, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, extended his hearty and warm welcome to the newly sworn-in Member of Parliament (**Hon. Alfred A. Thompson**). Mr. Speaker assured **Hon. Alfred A. Thompson** of his protection. He allocated a temporary seat to him until further notice.
