2. Suspension of Standing Order 5 (2)

The motion for the suspension of S O 5 (2) at 10:20 am was moved by **Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin** from **Bo District**. The motion was seconded by **Hon. Emilia Lolloh Tongi** from **Kailahun District** and approved by the House.

3. Adoption of the Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday 8th August 2024:

6. Standing Order 23 (Personal Explanation):

The following Hon. Members rose on S.O. 23:

- i. Hon. Juliana Aliematu Fatorma** from **Kenema District** stood on SO 23 and informed the House about deadly crocodiles in the rivers of two different chiefdoms in her district. She said four people had died including a child due to attacks by these crocodiles. She called on the attention of the House to come to their aid to help save lives and also help them with boats that would scared the crocodiles away and with other protective gears.

Mr. Speaker advised the Hon. Member to do a letter to that effect to the Chairman of Internal Affairs Committee and copy him.
- ii. Hon. P.C Paria Kandeh Kaawaleh II** from **Karene District**, rose on SO 23 and brought to the attention of the House that the bypass bridge from Karene District to Senehun had been destroyed by heavy trucks. He asked Mr. Speaker to please add his voice to the matter.
- iii. Hon. Komba Quee** from **Kono District**, stood on SO 23 and shared an unfortunate health situation he encountered during an oversight in Kenema. He called on the House to please consider the health conditions of former and current sitting Members of Parliament. He suggested that Hon. Members should be accompanied with health professionals in their oversight engagements. He further explained another unfortunate situation with regards identification of Hon. Members. He also pleaded that Hon. Members should be provided ID cards to avoid further embarrassment.
- iv. Hon. Mohamed Billoh Shaw** from **Falaba District** rose on SO 23 and reminded the House about the issue he raised the previous day about the Wellington-Masiaka high way. He asked Mr. Speaker to do justice for the nation by reviewing the contract between the government of Sierra Leone and the CRSG. He said the road was in a terrible state and they should act now for the better of the country.

- v. **Hon. Francis Amara Kaisamba** from **Kenema District**, stood on SO 23 and drew the attention of the House to the Sierra Leone Road Safety Authority (SLRSA) who are in charge of licenses of both vehicles and drivers licenses, and most importantly the safety of the roads. He said there had been lot of accidents on the roads which were as a result of stationary vehicles along the highways, and had resulted to the loss of many lives. He further said the SLRSA should be called upon to address this matter in order to reduce the number of accidents caused by stationary vehicles and to save lives.

Mr. Speaker directed the Ag. Deputy Clerk of Parliament to summon the Executive Director SLRSA to a meeting in his Chambers on Wednesday 14th August 2024 at 12:00 p.m.
