FELICITATIONS BY MR. SPEAKER

Mr. Speaker extended his felicitations to the newly-approved presidential nominees and wished them well in the execution of duty in their respective appointments.

12. STANDING ORDER 23 (Personal Explanations)

The following Hon. Members stood on S.O. 23:

- i. **Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella of Constituency 062, Kambia District** – He Spoke on behalf of the Chairman of the Parliamentary Committee on Agriculture, Forest and Food Security, **Hon. Foday Mario Kamara of Constituency 057, Kambia District**. He informed the House about the outbreak of the foot and mouth disease in Kambia District. He justified the absence of Hon. Foday Mario Kamara in the plenary proceedings as a result of the meeting of the Agriculture Committee with stakeholders. He also informed the House that he had been approached by some students enrolled at the Law School that they were deeply concerned about the substantial number of students that fail every year in the institution. The Hon. Member drew the attention of the House to the Administration of the Law School which does not make any response with regards the reason of the failure of students. He also said the students could

not identify where they went wrong since they had no access to their scripts. He called on the authorities responsible to address the issue.

- ii. **Response from Mr. Speaker** – With regards the concern raised by Hon. Dr. Kandeh Kolleh Yumkella, Mr. Speaker instructed the Chairman of the Committee on Education to engage the Minister of Higher Education, the Administration on the Law School and the Concerned Students to discuss the issue.
- iii. **Hon. Rtd. Capt. Maada Kanja Hafiju of Constituency 018, Kenema District** – The Hon. Member raised concern over the activities of a company called *Sea Wright*, which was supposed to be exploring mining sites on license number EL45-2011 issued 24th April, 2011 but instead engaged in full scale mining. He mentioned that the mining officer in charge of monitoring all mining sites of gold and diamond reported to him that the company was in possession of gold but had failed to give account of it.
- iv. **Hon. Sirajin Rollings-Kamara** – He drew the attention of the House to the statement that was made by His Excellency the President, Dr. Julius Maada Bio, in the Presidential Address to Parliament that he would ensure that there were enough school buses to facilitate the transportation of school going children to their respective schools. The Hon. Member hoped to see that in operation.
- v. **Hon. Momoh Bockarie of Constituency 012, Kenema District** – He reminded the House that there were outstanding issues that were yet to be reported to the House. He mentioned the case of Cederick Foray, who lost his life at the Freetown Amusement Park on his twelfth birthday as well as the Ad Hoc Committee on Youth Violence that were yet to be presented to the House.
- vi. **Response by Hon. Saa Emerson Lamina of Constituency 030, Kono District** – The Hon. Member responded that he had been constrained with the lack of cooperation from the Members of the Committee coupled with the delay of the production of the Hansard relating to that matter. Notwithstanding that, he said the report would be ready on the next adjourned date.
