



- 4. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2):

5. Adoption of Record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday, 11th April, 2019:

The motion for the adoption of the record of Votes and Proceedings for Thursday, 11th April, 2019 was moved by Hon. Alusine Kanneh of Constituency 013, Kenema District, seconded by Hon. Alice Jebbeh Kumabeh of Constituency 092, Bonthe District and adopted by the House.

6. Government Motion:

The Minister of Fisheries and Marine Resources:

Be it resolved: That this Honourable House ratify the following Agreements, which were laid on the Table of the House on Thursday 11th April, 2019:

- i. Agreement for the Implementation of the Provisions of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea of 10th December, 1982, relating to the Convention and Management of Straddling Fish Stocks and Highly Migratory Fish Stocks.
- ii. Agreement to Promote Compliance with International Convention and Management Measures by Fishing Vessels on the High Seas (The Compliance Agreement).

The Minister of Fisheries and Marine Resources, **Hon. Emma J. Kowa**, presented the motion to the House and moved its ratification.

7. Suspension of Standing Order 5(2):

Hon. Alice J. Kumabeh of Constituency 092, Bonthe District moved for the suspension of Standing Order 5(2) at 12:05p.m. for proceedings to continue during lunch. It was seconded By Hon. Joseph Williams-Lamin of Constituency 81, Bo District and approved by the House.

8. **Observation By Mr. Speaker:**

The Rt. Hon. Speaker observed that the overarching and umbrella Convention of the Law of the Sea was adopted in 1982, which amongst other things addressed the need for an additional Convention to elaborate and articulate the issue of the conservation and Management of the Straddling High Migratory Fish Stocks. This was accomplished in 1995 by the Convention relating to the Conservation and Management of Straddling Fish Stocks and Highly Migratory Fish Stocks. He was astonished that despite the adoption of the Convention in 1995, it was only brought to Parliament for ratification in 2019, 24 years later. He also said that in those 24 years, most countries in the sub-region must have completed their own process of ratification, putting Sierra Leone in a detrimental position. He said it was even possible that Sierra Leone was the only country in the sub-region still to ratify this important Convention. Therefore, he urged the Minister to do further enquiry on similar conventions of high importance that may still be gathering dust on the shelves of her Ministry.

The Hon. Speaker also drew the attention of the House to the Compliance Agreement by quoting Article III 1(a) which reads, "Each party shall take such measures as may be necessary to ensure that fishing vessels entitle to fly its flag do not engage in any activity that undermines the effectiveness of international conservation and management measures". The Hon. Speaker expressed the hope that the Minister would come back to Parliament with measures that she would like to propose for the country to ensure the strictest compliance with that particular obligation in the part of our State.





Continued debate:

11 Hon. Mathew S. Nyuma – Acting Leader of Government Business 019 Kenema

The Minister of Fisheries and Marine Resources responded to the issues raised by Honorable Members and again moved that the motion be ratified.

The question was put and agreed to.

The motion was ratified.

Hon. Rebecca Yei Kamara of Constituency 029, Kono District: rose on S.O. 19; the Hon. Member was guided by the Hon. Speaker on the procedures required to ask questions to Ministers in conformity with S.O.19 and 20.

Mr. Speaker: with regards the issue raised by Hon. Josephine Makieu of Constituency 014, Kenema District, the Hon. Speaker reminded the House about the reintroduction of Questions to Ministers, and urged Hon. Members to utilize its purpose. Question time he said was the most appropriate way to raise issues of public concern for the attention of responsible Ministers, and for action to be taken.

10. Recognition of Eminent Personality in the Chamber:

The Hon. Speaker recognized the presence of Hon. Rosaline J. Smith, former Member of Parliament.

11. Bereavement Announcement:

The Hon. Speaker made the following announcement:

- a. The laying out ceremony of the late **Hon. Momodu Eskimo Mansaray,** formally of **Constituency 043, Koinadugu District,** which would take place on Thursday, 25th April, 2019 at the State Hall, Parliament Building.
- b. He announced the passing away of the late **Hon. Major General Sheku Tarawally,** which took place on Wednesday, 10th April, 2019. He was a former Member of Parliament. The Hon. Speaker asked the House to rise and observe a *minute's silence* in honour of the deceased, and recited the conventional prayer,





'may his soul rest in peace'. He also informed the House that the laying out ceremony of the late **Hon.**Maj. Gen. Sheku Tarawally would be at the State Hall, Parliament Building on Monday 29th April, 2019.

12. Declaration of Vacant Seat in Parliament:

Mr. Speaker declared the seat of the late Hon. Momodu Eskimo Mansaray, Constituency 043, Koinadugu *vacant* and informed the House that the National Electoral Commission had to be in preparation for a byelection.
