RESPONSE BY THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN

Hon. Mathew Sahr Nyuma, Chairman of the Committee on Information and Communications responded to the issue raised by informing the House that he had started to address the issue of relieving personnel of their duty at NATCOM.

2. Hon. Ibrahim Ben Kargbo – Informed the House that the Head of Maritime Administration had been relieved of her duties followed by several others. He advised that the Board takes decisions that are consistent with the very Act that established it.

3. Hon. Dickson M. Rogers – Assured the House that there would be no increase in transport fare by appealing to the general public to report on fraudulent transport charges by drivers during the festive season.

5. **Hon. Mathew Sahr Nyuma** – Also informed the House about impersonators requesting monies from prominent citizens in the name of Members of Parliament.

6. **Hon. Amadu Kanu** – Informed the House that **P.C. Foday Mahoi of Moyamba** District had been reported very sick and that the final arrangement will be done on the 6th January, 2019. He also informed Members of a gruesome accident at the Magbang Bridge that took the lives of several people.

7. **Hon. Hassan A. Sesay** – That in the event of any situation in MDAs, the Act should be strictly adhered to in the appointment of Directors-General and their Deputies.

8. **Hon. Osman Abdal Timbo** – That during the early hours of Saturday, 15th December, 2018, a truck ran into a carnival in his constituency and killed four people, including the only daughter of one of his councilors.

9. **Hon. Sirajin Munirr Rolling-Kamara** – Reminded the House about the wedding ceremony of **Hon. Sahr Charles** in Kono District, which would be held on Saturday, 22nd December, 2018.

10. **Hon. James Ozan Tholley** – Informed the House about the passing away of his elder brother,

Alhaji Abass Tholley, a prominent business man, who would be laid to rest on Friday, 21st of December, 2018. He asked colleague Members to render their moral support towards the burial ceremony of his brother.

BEREAVEMENT

In respect of the above, Mr. Speaker asked all to rise and observe a minute's silence in honour of the deceased. He concluded by saying the prayer, "may the soul of **Alhaji Abass Tholley** rest in peace".

11. **Hon. Kadija Davies** – That a lady in her constituency went for a medical attention at the Emergency Hospital but was rejected; on her return home, she collapsed and was reported dead. She also reported a former S.L.P.P. aspirant for Member of Parliament who was in the habit of impersonating her authority.

12. **Hon. Ibrahim Tawa Conteh** –Commended Parliament and doffed his hat to the Speaker of Parliament, **Dr. Abass Chernor Bundu**, on his accomplishment and enthusiasm over very important deliberations within a specific period. He also extended sympathy to **Hon. Shiaka Musa Sama** who had been a victim of an unfortunate incident at Abuja that had gone viral.

13. **Hon. Shiaka Musa Sama** – Informed the House that on his way to his constituency, he saw a vehicle with an old MP number plate and tried to make an enquiry but to his surprise he was addressed as an impersonator by the owner of the vehicle. He also accused a staff of Parliament whom he said was responsible for creating the misinformation involving the rounds on social media about the incident at Abuja.
