VII. RESPONSE BY HON. CHERNOR R. M. BAH TO FELICITATION MESSAGES

The Deputy Speaker expressed his sincere thanks and appreciation to all those whose voices were heard in the Chamber as well as those who were unable to speak their voices. The Hon. Member assured the House that his heart will always be with Parliament and that Parliament will always be his “House”, in response to what the Deputy Minority Leader said earlier.
