VII. BILL:

The National Protected Area Authority and Conservation Trust Fund Act, 2012

INTRODUCTION AND FIRST READING:

The Bill was read the first time and accepted by a majority of votes.

SECOND READING, COMMITTEE STAGE AND THIRD READING:

The Deputy Minister of Agriculture,Forestry and Food Security, Mr. Lovell Thomas presented the Bill to Members of Parliament.

The Bill was read the second time and was unanimously accepted by Members.

VIII. AMENDMENTS:

1. **PART 2: 3(2)L:** to read thus: "One representative nominated by Civil Society Groups engaged in wild life conservation matters". To delete "coalition of Civil Societies".
2. **PART 2: Clause 10:** to add the words "with the approval of Parliament"

SUSPENSION OF STANDING ORDER 5(2) AT 12 NOON:

Hon. Ibrahim R.Bundu moved for the suspension of S.O. 5(2), seconded by **Hon. Manie Betts-Priddy**.

3. **PART 5: Clause 22(1):** numbering to be adjusted accordingly from (a) to (g).
4. **PART 5: Clause 20(2):** to read thus: "The President shall nominate one Member of the board as chairman of the Board of Trustees after consultation with the Minister and approval of Parliament".

THIRD READING AND PASSAGE INTO LAW:

The Bill was read the third time and passed into law.

IX. STANDING ORDER (S.O.)23:

Hon. Eric B. Jumu - Disclosed to the house that the services provided by mobile companies are still problematic, especially Sierratel with a new management whose agreement has not been presented to Parliament.

On the other hand with the political landscape, final compilation of voters' lists should precede Elections.

Also that there are some court cases involving embezzlement of funds by NEC Officials.

And that although the Sierra Leone Football Association (SLFA) Executive had been dissolved, the Minister was still interfering with the new Executive. This was a way of dampening the spirit of football fans in the country.

He called for tolerance at all levels of politicking.
