5. **Hon. M.Sufian Kargbo** - To proceed with the debate;

**Mr Speaker** - Requested the Minister to amend the Order Paper accordingly, since there were two documents, a convention and a constitution.

6. **Hon. Mathew S.Nyuma** - on a point of Order, S.O. 32 (8);

7. **Hon. Kondeh Y. Conteh** - on a point of clarification.
