**Hon. S.B.B. Dumbuya:**

1. A Pre-Legislative briefing on Wednesday, 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2012 on the Act entitled, "The National Pharmaceutical Commission Act, 2012", at 11:00 a.m. in Committee Room 1.

**IX. STANDING ORDER 23:**

The following Honourable Members stood on S.O. 23:

1. **Hon. Eric B. Jumu** - That the Act that was passed in Parliament prohibiting the use of Right hand vehicles has not been fully implemented as there are a lot of accidents on the highway and some other places. He called on the Road Transport Authority (RTA) to look into the matter;

Secondly, that the traffic barriers at State House to Parliament are still causing inconveniences to Members of Parliament.

2. **Hon. S.B.B. Dumbuya** - However disclosed that the barriers had been created because of security reasons and that not all Members of Parliament are allowed.
3. **Hon. Philip Tetema Tondoneh** - on the issue of the Free Health Care (Overruled as Controversial).  
That for informed decisions and clarity among Members of Parliament, Mr Speaker once Introduced "Speaker's Hour" with Members of Parliament, wherein Members would sit with Mr Speaker and the Leadership in Committee Room 1 to deliberate on pertinent issues relating to the welfare of Members of Parliament.
4. **Hon.Dr Bernadette Lahai** - That Saturday,30<sup>th</sup> June, 2012 according to the National Electoral Commission (NEC) is the day for the exhibition of voters registration and expected to last on to 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2012. In order to enhance the smooth running of this activity, vis aviz the work of Members of Parliament, appealed to Mr Speaker for

Members to be accorded the opportunity to be in their constituencies to sensitize their people.

5. **Hon. S.B.B. Dumbuya** - Replied that he got in touch with one of the Commissioners at NEC, Mrs Kebbie who promised to come to Parliament and brief Members on the issue.

Secondly, Hon.Dr Bernadette Lahai said that the Free Health Care which is goal four(4) of the Millennium Development Goals has been grossly violated as borne out by the heaps of garbage seen at Fouah Bay road, especially the ones in front of Princess Christian Maternity Hospital (PCMH), which is not good for the health of new born babies.
