The following amendments were made:

- 1. Under Section 2, Implementation (Part I), the definition of Medical Suppliers was set out as follows: "Medical Suppliers" means medical consumables including diagnostic and surgical appliances as approved by the Ministry of Health and Sanitation.
- 2. Part 1 under Implementation, last line, the words" Section 3"amended to read "Section 2".
- 3. Part 5, clause 2(f) last line to read: District "Health Management team" instead of District "Health Medical team".

#### VIII. STATEMENT BY MR SPEAKER:

Informed Members of Parliament that he had received a written communication from the SLPP Party, informing him of the appointment of a new SLPP Minority Leader in the person of Hon. Emmanuel W.Tommy.

The Speaker requested Hon. Emmanuel W. Tommy to assume his rightful seat which he did.

Secondly, that the new Deputy Minority Leader is Hon. Ansumana J. Kaikai, who was also requested by Mr Speaker to assume his rightful seat next to the Minority Leader.

Thirdly, Mr Speaker requested the Minority Whip, Hon.Komba E. Koedoyoma to assume his rightful seat next after the Deputy Minority Leader.

On behalf of the entire House of Parliament, Mr Speaker congratulated the Minority

Leader and his Deputy on their new positions.

#### IX. STANDING ORDER 23:

The following Honourable Members stood on S.O. 23:

1. Hon. Sam-May L. Macarthy - That certain Activities are going on in his constituency which are a breach of the Chieftaincy Act (Overruled as controversial).

He further explained that what transpired was a human rights issue and a breach of the Chieftaincy Act as the procedures to remove a town chief were not followed. S.O 23 -That the Paramount Chief Prince Metzger Bondo Konneh II of Makpelle Chiefdom Pujehun District was seriously sick (tradition could not permit him to say exactly the thing).

- 2. Hon. Solomon W. Feika S.O 23 -That the Paramount Chief Prince Metzger Bondo Konneh II of Makpelle Chiefdom, Pujehun District was seriously sick (tradition could not permit him to say exactly the thing).
- Hon. Alpha Babatunde Lewally That the issue raised last Tuesday in the well of Parliament in connection with the heaps of garbage seen at Fourah Bay road, especially the ones in front of Princess Christian Maternity Hospital (PCMH), has been addressed and that the garbage had been removed. He thanked the Minister of Local Government for his assistance in clearing the garbage.
- 4. **Hon.Morlai B.S. Kamara** -That he had a bitter experience at Lungi with a group of youths who called themselves tax collectors, harassing people for the collection of local tax by blockading the road and causing delays on the high way. He said, he was delayed for some time inspite of his self-introduction as a Member of Parliament.
- 5. Hon. Emmanuel W. Tommy Thanked God for his new position, and his SLPP Colleagues who consented unanimously to allow him the position of Leadership in the House of Parliament.

That he was prepared to cooperate with the ruling Government, but not to compromise with things that would not work for Sierra Leone.
